PASTOR'S CORNER

PRAYER OF THE HEART (11)

**The prayer of heart to Heart communication with the
Persons of the Holy Trinity**

After finishing Step One by meditating on the Blessings of the Really Real and the Eternal, topped off by a focus on the Blessings of Redemption, I am in touch with the irrefutable evidence that I am infinitely loved by God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. This transforms my negative superficial feelings into deep positive feelings. They rise up within me and trigger a response of thanksgiving and praise to God.

I am now ready to move on to **Step Two** in my method of **Prayer of the Heart**. I cannot wish my negative feelings away. While keeping my focus on the blessing of God's love for me, I need to deal with my awareness of what is missing in my life. If you are like me, you have already forgotten what I published in the Pastor's Corner of November 28, 2021. Because of its relevance I repeat it here.

in this world wounded by sin I am missing perfect comfort, perfect health, perfect relationships, perfect job success, perfect peace, perfect financial security, etc. These negative feelings pull me toward discouragement, stress, anxiety and worry. In **Step 2. I use my own words to confide my difficulties, problems, anxieties and needs to Jesus. I ask for His help. I seek his counsel by asking Him a good question. A good question generates good listening. I make myself listen for his "still, small voice" for at least two or three minutes as I pray, "Speak Lord, your servant is listening."**

When I was young and my life was more dominated by insecurity and fear, which arises from the wound of lack of trust in God, I had trouble hearing God on the personal level of my unique circumstances and needs. I wanted God to hit me over the head with a 2X4 to get my attention and then yell in my ear. He seemed to do that for Saul of Tarsus on the road to Damascus, so why not for me? As long as I insisted that God speak to me in that way, it seemed that all I got was the silent treatment. As I matured and payed attention to reliable witnesses, I began to learn to listen for God's "still, small voice." **I learned that the God, Who Is Love, speaks in a still, small voice in order to enable my free responses to His loving initiatives.** Free will is what makes love possible and my participation in the love of self-gift is what God really cares about

One of my default questions is to ask Jesus how He wants me to prioritize my activities in the day ahead. When thoughts in my head begin to "ring true" I jot them down in my prayer journal note book for the sake of making a good discernment of how I should follow Jesus in a practical way in the day ahead.

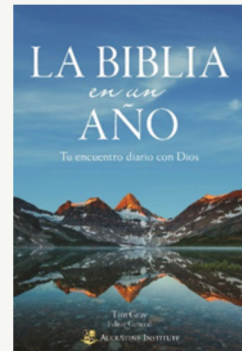
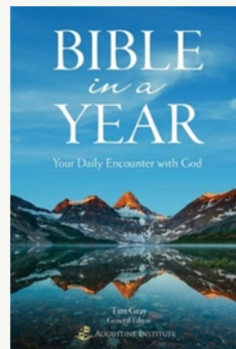

La oración de Corazón a Corazón comunicación con las Personas de la Santísima Trinidad

Después de terminar el Primer Paso de meditación en las Bendiciones de lo Realmente Real y Eterno, rematado por un enfoque en las Bendiciones de la Redención, estoy en contacto con la evidencia irrefutable de que soy infinitamente amado por Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Esto transforma mis sentimientos superficiales negativos en sentimientos profundos y positivos. Se levantan dentro de mí y desencadenan una respuesta de acción de gracias y alabanza a Dios.

Ahora estoy listo para pasar al **Segundo Paso** en mi método de **Oración del Corazón**. No puedo desear que mis sentimientos negativos desaparezcan. Mientras mantengo mi enfoque en la bendición del amor de Dios por mí, necesito lidiar con mi conciencia de lo que falta en mi vida. Si eres como yo, ya te olvidaste lo que publiqué en el Rincón del Párroco del 28 de noviembre de 2021. Por su relevancia lo repito aquí.

en este mundo herido por el pecado me falta la comodidad perfecta, la salud perfecta, las relaciones perfectas, el éxito laboral perfecto, la paz perfecta, la seguridad económica perfecta, etc. Estos sentimientos negativos me llevan al desánimo, el estrés, la ansiedad y la preocupación. En el **Segundo Paso. Utilizo mis propias palabras para confiarle mis dificultades, problemas, ansiedades y necesidades a Jesús. Le pido su ayuda. Busco su consejo haciéndole una buena pregunta. Una buena pregunta genera una buena escucha. Me obligo a escuchar su "voz suave y apacible" durante al menos dos o tres minutos mientras oro: "Habla Señor, tu siervo está escuchando".**

Cuando era joven y mi vida estaba más dominada por la inseguridad y el miedo, que surge de la herida de la falta de confianza en Dios, tenía problemas para escuchar a Dios en el nivel personal de mis circunstancias y necesidades únicas. Quería que Dios me golpeará en la cabeza con un 2X4 para llamar mi atención y luego me gritara al oído. Parecía hacer eso por Saulo de Tarso en el camino a Damasco, así que ¿por qué no por mí? Mientras insistí en que Dios me hablara de esa manera, parecía que todo lo que recibía era el trato silencioso. A medida que maduraba y prestaba atención a testigos confiables, comencé a aprender a escuchar la "voz suave y apacible" de Dios. **Aprendí que Dios, que es amor, habla con una voz suave y apacible para permitirme responder libremente a sus iniciativas amorosas.** El libre albedrío es lo que hace posible el amor y mi participación en el amor de la donación es lo que realmente le importa a Dios.

Una de mis preguntas predeterminadas es preguntarle a Jesús cómo quiere que dé prioridad a mis actividades en el día siguiente. Cuando los pensamientos en mi cabeza comienzan a "sonar verdaderos", los anoto en mi cuaderno de notas del diario de oración con el fin de hacer un buen discernimiento de cómo debo seguir a Jesús de una manera práctica en el día que viene.

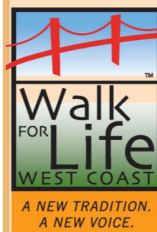

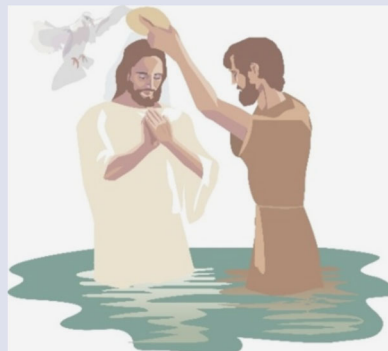
