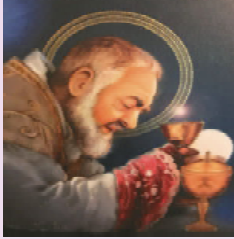

## EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL (4) - NEED PASTORS CORNER

**“God, who is all wise, knew not how to give more;  
God, who is all rich, had not the means of giving more;  
God who is all powerful, could not give more.”**

**By St. Augustine**



The following paragraphs are taken from the Catechism of the Catholic Church. These words come from the Church’s Deposit of Faith. They partially fulfill Jesus’ promise to his apostles at the Last Supper: “I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth” (John 16:12-13).

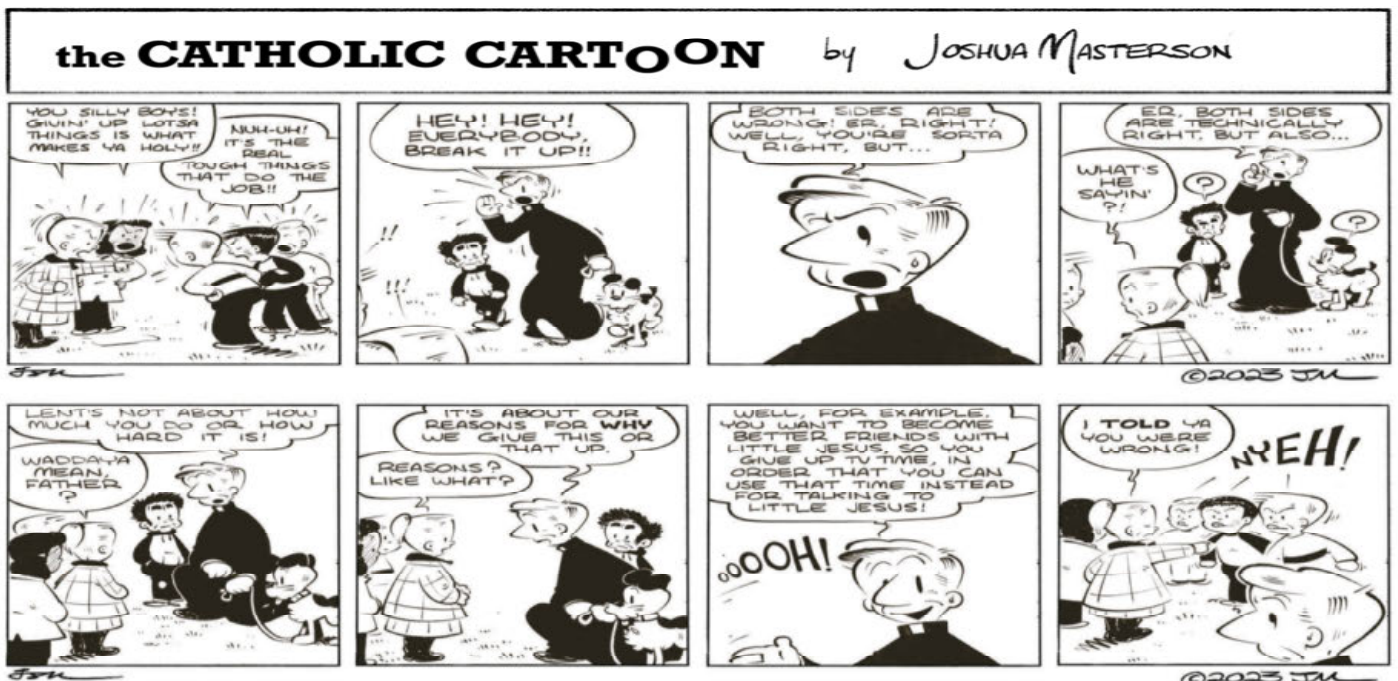
CCC 1336 The first announcement of the Eucharist divided the disciples, just as the announcement of the Passion scandalized them: “This is a hard saying; who can listen to it?” (Jn 6:60). The Eucharist and the Cross are stumbling blocks. It is the same mystery and it never ceases to be an occasion of division. “Will you also go away?” (Jn 6:67). The Lord’s question echoes through the ages, as a loving invitation to discover that only he has “the words of eternal life” (Jn 6:68), and that to receive in faith the gift of his Eucharist is to receive the Lord himself.

### THE INSTITUTION OF THE EUCHARIST

CCC 1337 The Lord, having loved those who were his own, loved them to the end. Knowing that the hour had come to leave this world and return to the Father, in the course of a meal he washed their feet and gave them the commandment of love (Jn 13:1-17; 34-35). In order to leave them a pledge of this love, in order never to depart from his own and to make them sharers in his Passover, he instituted the Eucharist as the memorial of his death and Resurrection, and commanded his apostles to celebrate it until his return; “thereby he constituted them priests of the New Testament” (Council of Trent (1562) DS 1740).

CCC 1340 By celebrating the Last Supper with his apostles in the course of a Passover meal, Jesus gave the Jewish Passover its definitive meaning. Jesus’ passing over to his father by his death and Resurrection, the new Passover, is anticipated in the Supper and celebrated in the Eucharist, which fulfills the Jewish Passover and anticipates the final Passover of the Church in the glory of the kingdom.

### LENT, FAST, & ABSTINENCE

**LENT:** is a time of conversion and turning back to God. It is a time to reflect, renew and Prayer, Fasting, an almsgiving reach out are the disciplines incorporated into daily life.

**ABSTINENCE:** from meats is to be observed by all Catholics 14 of age and older on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays of Lent.

**FASTING:** is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59 years of age. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

Los siguientes párrafos están tomados del Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica. Estas palabras provienen del Depósito de la Fe de la Iglesia. Cumplen parcialmente la promesa de Jesús a sus apóstoles en la Última Cena: “Tengo todavía que deciros, pero ahora no podéis con ello. Cuando venga él, el Espíritu de la verdad, os guiará hasta la verdad completa” (Juan 16:12-13).

CIC 1336 El primer anuncio de la Eucaristía dividió a los discípulos, igual que el anuncio de la Pasión los escandalizó: “Es duro este lenguaje; ¿Quién puede escucharlo? (Jn 6:60). La Eucaristía y la Cruz son piedra de tropiezo. Es el mismo misterio y no cesa de ser ocasión de división. &quot;¿También vosotros queréis marcharos? (Jn 6:67): esta pregunta del Señor resuena a través de las edades, como invitación de su amor a descubrir que sólo Él tiene “palabras de vida eterna” (Jn 6,68), y que acoger en la fe el don de su Eucaristía es acogerlo a El mismo. La Institución de la Eucaristía

CIC 1337 El Señor, habiendo amado a los suyos, los amó hasta el fin. Sabiendo que había llegado la hora de partir de este mundo para retornar a su Padre, en el transcurso de una cena, les lavó los pies y les dio el mandamiento del amor (Jn 13, 1-17; 34-35). Para dejarles prenda de este amor, para no alejarse nunca de los suyos y hacerlos partícipes de su Pascua, instituyó la Eucaristía como memorial de su muerte y de su resurrección, y ordenó a sus apóstoles celebrarlo hasta su retorno, “constituyéndoles entonces del Nuevo Testamento” (Concilio de Trento (1562) DS 1740).

### La Institución de la Eucaristía

CIC 1340 Al celebrar la Última Cena con sus apóstoles en el transcurso del banquete pascual, Jesús dio su sentido definitivo a la pascua judía. En efecto, el paso de Jesús a su Padre por su muerte y resurrección, la Pascua nueva, es anticipada en la Cena y celebrada en la Eucaristía que cumplimiento a la Pascua judía y anticipa la Pascua final de la Iglesia en la gloria del Reino.
