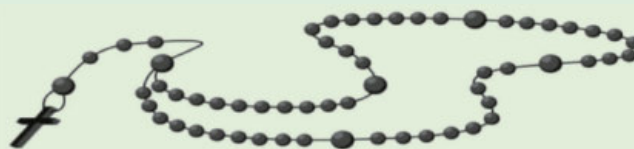

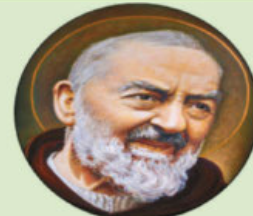

EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL (8)



THE MOVEMENT OF THE EUCHARISTIC CELEBRATION

CCC 1346 The liturgy of the Eucharist unfolds according to a fundamental structure which has been preserved throughout the centuries down to our own day. It displays two great parts that form a fundamental unity:

- ♦ the gathering, the liturgy of the Word, with readings, homily and general intercessions;
- ♦ the liturgy of the Eucharist, with the presentation of the bread and wine, the consecratory thanksgiving, and communion.

The liturgy of the Word and the liturgy of the Eucharist together form “one single act of worship;” the Eucharistic table set for us is the table both of the Word of God and the Body of the Lord.

CCC 1348. ...At its head is Christ himself, the principal agent of the Eucharist.

He is high priest of the New Covenant;

it is he himself who presides invisibly over every Eucharistic celebration.

It is in representing him that the bishop or priest acting in the person of Christ the head (in persona Christi capitis) presides over the assembly, speaks after the readings, receives the offerings, and says the Eucharistic Prayer. All have their own active parts to play in the celebration, each in his own way: readers, those who bring up the offerings, those who give communion, and the whole people whose “Amen” manifests their participation.

CCC 1355 ... Because this bread and wine have been made Eucharist

(“eucharisted,” according to an ancient expression),

“we call this food Eucharist, and no one may take part in it

Unless he believes that what we teach is true,

has received baptism for the forgiveness of sins and new birth,

and lives in keeping with what Christ taught.” (St. Justin – 155 AD)

RENOVACIÓN EUCARÍSTICA (8)



EL MOVIMIENTO DE LA CELEBRACIÓN EUCARÍSTICA

CIC 1346 La liturgia de la Eucaristía se desarrolla conforme a una estructura fundamental que se ha conservado a través de los siglos hasta nuestros. Comprende dos grandes momentos que forman una unidad básica:

- ♦ la reunión, la liturgia de la Palabra, con las lecturas, la homilía y la oración universal;
- ♦ la liturgia eucarística, con la presentación del pan y del vino, la acción de gracias consecratoria y la comunión.

Liturgia de la Palabra y la liturgia eucarística constituyen juntas “un solo acto de culto”; en efecto, la mesa preparada para nosotros en la Eucaristía es a la vez la de la Palabra de Dios y la del Cuerpo del Señor.

CIC 1348. ...A su cabeza está Cristo mismo que es el actor principal de la Eucaristía.

Él es sumo sacerdote de la Nueva Alianza;

El mismo quien preside invisiblemente toda celebración eucarística.

Como representante suyo, el obispo o el presbítero (actuando “in person Christi capitis” – “en la persona de Cristo cabeza”) preside la asamblea, toma la palabra después de las lecturas, recibe las ofrendas y dice la plegaria eucarística. Todos tienen parte activa en la celebración, cada uno a su manera: los lectores, los que presentan las ofrendas, los que dan la comunión, y el pueblo entero cuyo “Amen” manifiesta su participación.

CIC 1355 ... Y este alimento se llama entre nosotros

“Eucaristía”, de la que a nadie es lícito participar

sino al que cree ser verdaderas nuestras enseñanzas

y se ha lavado en el baño que da la remisión de los pecados y la regeneración,
