SYNOD INFORMATION

WHAT IS THE AIM FOR THIS SYNOD? :

This Synod is intended as a **Synodal Process**. The aim of this synodal process is not to provide a temporary or one-time experience of synodality, but rather to provide an opportunity for the entire People of God to discern together how to move forward on the path towards being a more synodal Church in the long-term.

A basic question prompts and guides us: How does this journeying together allow the Church to proclaim the Gospel in accordance with the mission entrusted to Her; and what steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow as a synodal Church?

WHO IS THE SYNOD FOR?

By convoking this Synod, Pope Francis is inviting all the baptized to participate in this Synodal Process that begins at the diocesan level.

The main subjects of this synodal experience are all the baptized, because all the baptized are the subject of the **sensus fidelium**, the living voice of the **People of God**. At the same time, in order to participate fully in the act of discerning, it is important for the baptized to hear the voices of other people in their local context, including people who have left the practice of the faith, people of other faith traditions, people of no religious belief.

HOW CAN I PARTICIPATE IN THE SYNOD?

Everybody can actively participate in the synodal journeying with his/her prayer. The Synodal Process is first and foremost a spiritual process. It is not a mechanical data-gathering exercise or a series of meetings and debates. To help people in praying the www.prayforthesynod.va website has been implemented.

THE TEN SYNOD THEMES TO EXPLORE & QUESTIONS TO DISCUSS

1. THE JOURNEYING COMPANIONS:

(In the Church and in society, we are side by side on the same road.)

- A. When we say “our Church,” who is part of it?
- B. Do I feel invited to be part of the journey?
- C. When have I felt that I was or was not invited to the journey?
- D. Have I seen or experienced persons or groups who have not felt invited to be part of the journey?

2. LISTENING:

(Listening is the first step, but it requires having an open mind and heart, without prejudices.)

- A. In your experience, to whom does your local parish Church “need to listen to”?
- B. In your experience, to whom does the Church at large need to listen to?

3. SPEAK OUT:

(All are invited to speak with courage and boldness, that is, integrating freedom, truth and charity.)

- A. Are you aware if your parish has resources where you may share your concerns with truth, charity, and boldness?

4. CELEBRATING:

(“Journeying Together” is only possible if it is based on communal listening to the Word and the celebration of the Eucharist.)

- A. How does prayer and liturgical celebrations (Mass and Communal Prayer) at my parish inspire and guide our “journeying together”?
- B. Do you feel engaged in the liturgy and prayer life of your parish community?

5. CO – RESPONSIBLE IN THE MISSION:

(Synodality is at the service of the Church’s mission, in which all her members are called to participate.)

- A. We are called to be missionary disciples, how are you, as a baptized person, called to participate in the mission of proclaiming the Gospel?
- B. How is your parish living the mission of proclaiming the Gospel?

6. DIALOGUE IN THE CHURCH & SOCIETY:

(Dialogue is a path of perseverance that is ideally capable of gathering experiences of all persons, including those who feel they have been silenced or have been suffering in silence.)

- A. Does your parish engage with other believers and with non-believers?
- B. Is there a place for your parish members to dialogue openly?
- C. How have differing opinions been addressed at your parish?

7. WITH THE OTHER CHRISTIAN CONFESSIONS:

(The dialogue between Christians of different confessions, united by one Baptism, has a special place in the synodal journey.)

- A. What relations does your parish have with the brother and sisters of other Christian denominations?
- B. What areas do they concern?
- C. What fruits have we drawn from this “journeying together”?
- D. What are the difficulties?

8. AUTHORITY & PARTICIPATION:

(A synodal Church is a listening Church that provides opportunities to listen to the Holy Spirit and People of God in order to discern together and walk forward on a common path.)

- A. How does your parish identify the goals to be pursued, the way to achieve them and the steps to be taken?
- B. How are the practices of teamwork, co-responsibility, and lay ministries promoted in your parish?

9. CONFESS DISCERNING & DECIDING:

(In a synodal style, decisions are made through discernment, based on a consensus that flows from the common obedience to the Holy Spirit.)

- A. By what procedures and methods do we discern together and make decisions?
- B. How can they be improved?

10. FORMING OURSELVES IN SYNODALITY:

(Journeying together calls us to lifelong formation and growth in our Christian faith.)

- A. How does your parish provide the tools you need to be a disciple of Jesus Christ?
- B. How does your parish provide opportunities for praying together, listening to one another, and engaging in dialogue as a community of believers to further the mission of the Gospel?



INFORMACIÓN DEL SÍNODO

¿CUÁL ES EL OBJETIVO DE ESTE SÍNODO? :

Este Sínodo pretende ser un **Proceso Sinodal**. El objetivo de este proceso sinodal no es brindar una experiencia temporal o puntual de sinodalidad, sino brindar una oportunidad a todo el Pueblo de Dios para discernir juntos cómo avanzar en el camino hacia una Iglesia más sinodal a largo plazo.

Una pregunta de fondo nos impulsa y nos guía: ¿Cómo este caminar juntos permite a la Iglesia anunciar el Evangelio según la misión que le ha sido encomendada? y ¿qué pasos nos invita el Espíritu a dar para crecer como Iglesia sinodal?

¿PARA QUIÉN ES EL SÍNODO?

Con la convocatoria de este Sínodo, el Papa Francisco invita a todos los bautizados a participar en este Proceso Sinodal que comienza a nivel diocesano.

Los sujetos principales de esta experiencia sinodal son todos los bautizados, porque todos los bautizados son sujetos del **sensus fidelium**, voz viva del **Pueblo de Dios**. Al mismo tiempo, para participar plenamente en el acto de discernir, es importante que los bautizados escuchen las voces de otras personas en su contexto local, incluidas las personas que han abandonado la práctica de la fe, las personas de otras tradiciones religiosas, personas sin creencias religiosas.

¿CÓMO PUEDO PARTICIPAR EN EL SÍNODO?

Todos pueden participar activamente en el camino sinodal con su oración. El Proceso sinodal es ante todo un proceso espiritual. No es un ejercicio mecánico de recopilación de datos o una serie de reuniones y debates. Para ayudar a las personas a orar, se ha implementado el sitio web www.prayforthesynod.va y compartiendo sus oraciones.

DIEZ TEMAS PARA EXPLORAR Y PREGUNTAS PARA DISCUTIR

1. LOS COMPAÑEROS DE VIAJE:

(En la iglesia y en la sociedad estamos en el mismo camino uno al lado del otro.)

- ¿Cuando decimos “nuestra iglesia” ¿quien es parte de ella?
- ¿Me siento invitado a ser parte del viaje?
- ¿Cuando he sentido que fui o no invitado al viaje?
- ¿He visto o experimentado personas o grupos que no se han sentido invitados a ser parte del viaje?

2. ESCUCHAR:

(Escuchar es el primer paso, pero exige tener una mente y un corazón abiertos, sin prejuicios.)

- ¿En tu experiencia, ¿a quien “necesita escuchar” tu iglesia local?
- ¿En tu experiencia, ¿a quien necesita escuchar la iglesia en general?

3. TOMAR LA PALABRA:

(Todos están Invitados a hablar con valentía y audacia es decir integrando libertad, verdad y caridad.)

- ¿Sabes si tu parroquia tiene recursos donde puedas compartir tus preocupaciones con la verdad, la caridad y la audacia?

4. CELEBRAR:

(“Caminar juntos” solo es posible sobre si se basa en la escucha comunitaria de la Palabra y de la celebración de la Eucaristía)

- ¿Cómo inspiran y orientan efectivamente nuestro “caminar juntos” la oración y la celebración litúrgica ?
- ¿Te sientes comprometido/conectado en la liturgia y la vida de oración de tu comunidad parroquial ?

5. CORRESPONSABLES EN LA MISIÓN :

(La sinodalidad esta al servicio de la misión de la iglesia en la que todos sus miembros están llamados a participar.)

- ¿Cuales son las dificultades?

8. AUTORIDAD Y PARTICIPACIÓN:

(Una Iglesia sinodal es una Iglesia que escucha y que ofrece oportunidad para escuchar al Espíritu Santo y al Pueblo de Dios para discernir juntos y caminar hacia adelante en un camino común.)

- ¿Cómo se pueden mejorar?

10. FORMARSE EN LA SINODALIDAD :

(Caminar juntos nos llama a la formación y al crecimiento de por vida en nuestra fe cristiana.)

- ¿Como proporciona tu parroquia las herramientas que necesitas para ser discípulo de Jesucristo ?
- ¿Cómo proporciona tu parroquia oportunidades para orar juntos, escucharse unos a otros y participar en el dialogo como comunidad de creyentes para promover la misión del Evangelio?

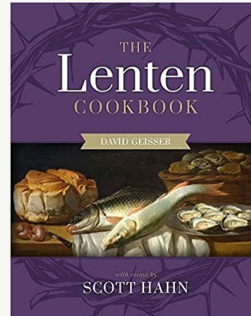
