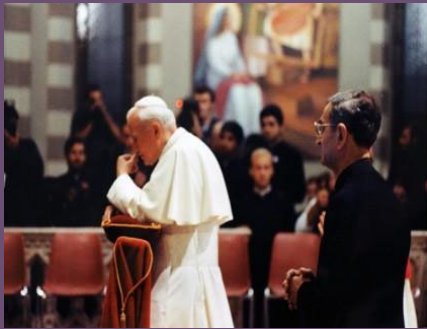

THEOLOGY OF THE BODY (3)

Our secular culture has lost touch with the God-given meaning of sexuality, marriage and gender. St. John Paul II referred to our secular culture as a “culture of death.” “*God did not create death, and He takes no pleasure in the death of the living. ...Death entered our world through the envy of the devil.*” (Wisdom 1:13; 2:24). What was the devil envious of? Here is Christopher West’s train of thought in the wake of that question.



St. John Paul II

“Satan hates the WOMAN and her ability to bear offspring. We are the strange bridge between the angels and the animals. In the Incarnation, God would take on the lowliness of flesh and raise it higher than the angels. What do we have that angels do not have? BODIES! What can we do that angels cannot do? PROCRE-ATE!, that is, participate in the power of creation. More stunning than the creation of the Milky Way Galaxy or the Himalayan Mountain Range is the procreation of a human baby. Satan hates our bodies. And Satan wants us to hate our bodies too.

Governments are asking us to identify everybody without reference to any *body*. St. John Paul II revived the Church’s incarnational – sacramental view of the BODY in his teaching called “Theology of the Body.”

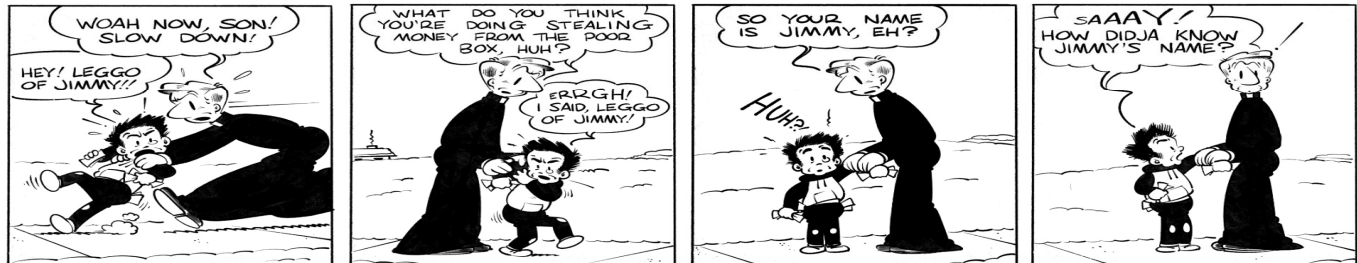

Teología del Cuerpo (3)

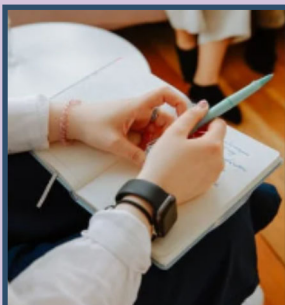

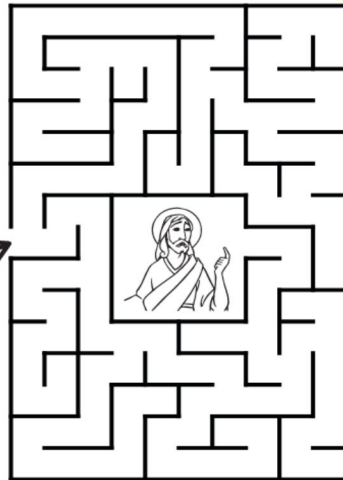

MORE THAN FOUR SUNDAYS

To have a really fruitful Advent, it is necessary to actively celebrate the liturgical feasts of the season! This involves attending Holy Mass on the four Sundays of Advent, but there are also weekday Liturgical Feasts that have a strong connection to the Season. There are family activities associated with certain feast days that will appeal to children's imaginations and give them fond memories of the Advent season.



DECEMBER 6 SAINT NICHOLAS

(Patron of children)
Some families have the children put their shoes out the night before, to find some small gift or coin in them in the morning!



DECEMBER 8 SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

(Patroness of the USA)
This solemnity celebrates that the virgin Mary was conceived without original sin in the womb of her mother Saint Anne.

CHRIST IS COMING

The word Advent comes from Latin Adventus, which means "coming" or "arrival." During the Advent Season, we prepare our hearts and homes for two "arrivals" of Christ.

His First Coming: We prepare to celebrate the first coming of Jesus as a humble baby- acknowledging and worshipping Jesus the Messiah, the Savior of the world.

His Final Coming: We prepare to meet the Second Coming of Jesus as judge, at our death
