Pastor's Corner - THEOLOGY OF THE BODY (4)

Is it okay to sterilize the marriage act?; to use the marriage act to get sexual pleasure, but sterilize it in order to avoid the burden of pregnancy? After all, there is a lot of time, sacrifice, expense and suffering that goes into supporting a helpless infant and to meet its childhood and adolescent needs for years until it is able to be self-supporting and productive. And let's be honest, a disproportionate amount of this suffering and sacrifice usually falls on the shoulders of the woman. Is that fair?

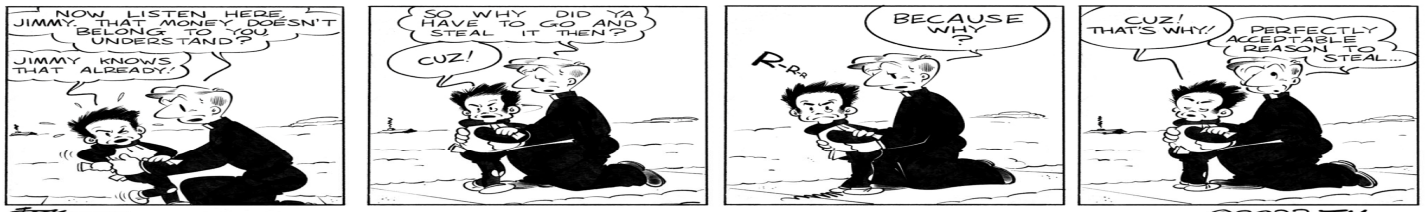
Is it okay to terminate a pregnancy when it happens to be inconvenient? After all, where is the evidence that the human embryo and fetus have the qualities that give it the dignity of human personhood and, consequently, the inalienable rights of life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness?

In pondering and answering these questions, to whom will we listen?

ONE? To the murderer, accuser and father of lies who tells us: "You certainly will not die! No, God knows well that the moment you eat of it (the tree of the knowledge of good and evil), your eyes will be opened and you will be like gods who know what is good and what is evil. (Genesis 3:4-5)? In the ancient Hebrew culture, these words would be understood as, "You can be your own god, determining for yourself what is good and what is evil, without respect to any higher authority." This sin of pride, this rebellion of the creature against the Creator, is called, Original Sin, by the Church. We have all inherited the wound of Original Sin, which is lack of trust in God, because we are related to Adam and Eve. Another way to recognize Original Sin at work in our culture is the worldview called "relativism." Relativism means there is no absolute truth. Truth is relative to the opinion of each individual human being.

Or, TWO? Will we listen to the God of Truth, Goodness, Beauty, Love, Mercy, justice, Power, Glory and Life, Who has revealed His Essence most fully through the Mystical Marriage of Divinity with humanity in the Incarnation of Jesus Christ, True God, and true man? In weeks to come we will try to listen to God through Sacred Tradition, Sacred Scripture and the Teaching Authority Jesus established in His One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.

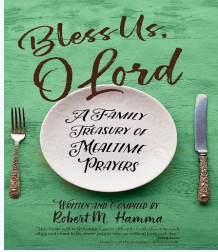

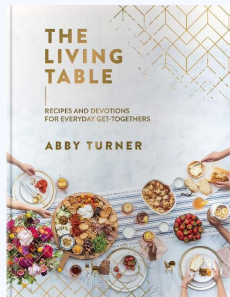

¿Está bien esterilizar el acto matrimonial?; usar el acto matrimonial para obtener placer sexual, pero esterilizarlo para evitar la carga del embarazo? Después de todo, se necesita mucho tiempo, sacrificio, gasto y sufrimiento para mantener a un bebé indefenso y satisfacer sus necesidades de la niñez y la adolescencia durante años hasta que pueda ser autosuficiente y productivo. Seamos honestos, una cantidad desproporcionada de este sufrimiento y sacrificio suele recaer sobre los hombros de la mujer. ¿Es eso justo?

¿Está bien interrumpir un embarazo cuando resulta inconveniente? Después de todo, ¿dónde está la evidencia de que el embrión y el feto humano tienen las cualidades que le otorgan la dignidad de la persona humana y, en consecuencia, los derechos inalienables a la vida, la libertad y la búsqueda de la felicidad? **Al meditar y responder estas preguntas, ¿a quién escucharemos?**



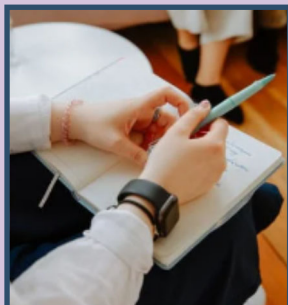
¿UNA? Al asesino, acusador y padre de la mentira que nos dice: “¿De ninguna manera moriréis! Es que Dios sabe muy bien que el día en que comiereis de él (del árbol de la ciencia del bien y del mal), se os abrirán los ojos y seréis como dioses, conocedores del bien y del mal. (Génesis 3:4-5)? En la Antigua cultura hebrea, estas palabras se entenderían como: “Puedes ser tu propio dios, determinando por ti mismo lo que es bueno y lo que es malo, sin respeto a ninguna autoridad superior”. Este pecado de soberbia, esta rebelión de la criatura contra el Creador, es llamado Pecado Original por la Iglesia. Todos hemos heredado la herida del Pecado Original, que es la falta de confianza en Dios, porque estamos emparentados con Adán y Eva. Otra forma de reconocer el pecado original en acción en nuestra cultura es la cosmovisión llamada “relativismo”. El relativismo significa que no hay una verdad absoluta. La verdad es relativa a la opinión de cada ser humano individual.



¿O dos? ¿Escucharemos al Dios de la Verdad, ¿la Bondad, la Belleza, el Amor, la Misericordia, la Justicia, el Poder, la Gloria y la Vida, que ha revelado su Esencia de la manera más plena a través del Matrimonio Místico de la Divinidad con la humanidad en la Encarnación de Jesucristo, Dios Verdadero, y verdadero hombre? En las próximas semanas trataremos de escuchar a Dios a través de la Sagrada Tradición, la Sagrada Escritura y la Autoridad Docente que Jesús estableció en Su Iglesia Una, Santa, Católica y Apostólica.
