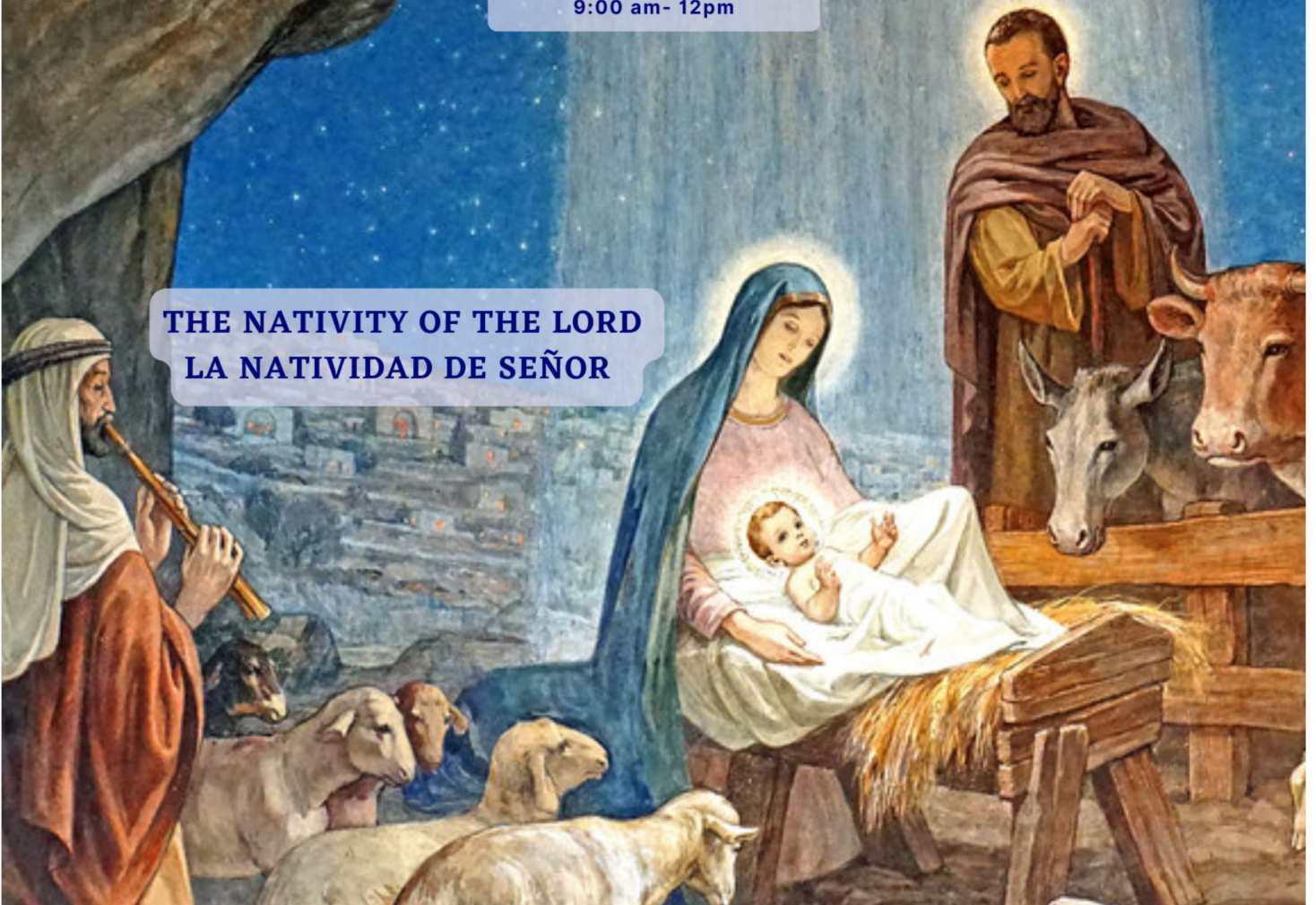

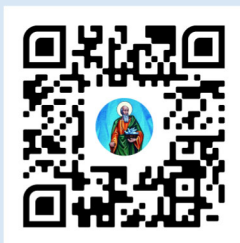

Pastor's Corner - THEOLOGY OF THE BODY (6)



Is the decision moral or immoral, to deliberately sterilize the marriage act through some contraceptive means, or, to abort the new life in the womb because the pregnancy is burdensome? The reason I am tying the question of the morality of contraception and abortion together is because the lived experience of many people is that if “safe sex” by contraception fails, then abortion can be justified.

In the 1992 Supreme Court decision called *Planned Parenthood v. Casey*, Judge Kennedy stated, “For two decades of economic and social developments, people have organized intimate relationships and made choices that define their views of themselves and their places in society, in reliance on the availability of abortion in the event that contraception should fail.”

But are the decisions to contracept and/or to abort moral, that is, are they in accord with God’s Truth and Love? Judge Kennedy went on to write, “At the heart of liberty is the right to define one’s own concept of existence, of meaning, of the universe and the mystery of human life.” I submit to you that this statement is an effort to establish the state of Original Sin as a human right!!!

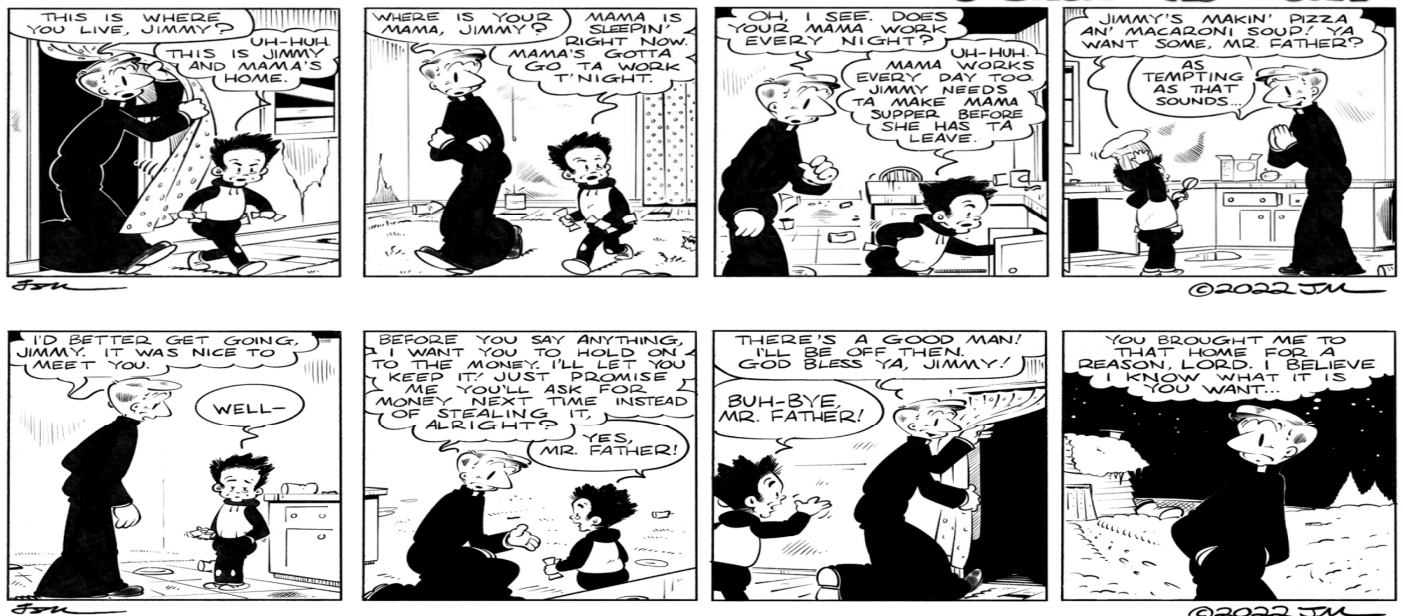
Philosophy Professor, Janet Smith, comments as follows, “This passage reflects the individualism and skepticism that leads to relativism. It suggests that there is no meaning to reality that we all must discover and live by; rather it states that we are to be free to define – not to discover, but to define – the meaning of existence.” (*The Right To Privacy*, by Janet E. Smith, p. 52). In other words, Judge Kenedy, speaking for the dominant secular culture, is affirming the “right” of human beings to act as their own gods, that is, to determine for themselves what is good and what is evil, what is moral and what is immoral, without respect to any higher authority.

As disciples of Jesus Christ, who is the Way, the Truth and the Life, we are being empowered to be witnesses of the God-given meaning of human life, of human sexuality, of human marriage and family. St. John Paul II’s Theology of the Body can guide us to a profound understanding of these meanings. TOB can help us appreciate and celebrate the awesome meaning of the Incarnation and the Birth of Jesus. Merry Christmas! (More to come).

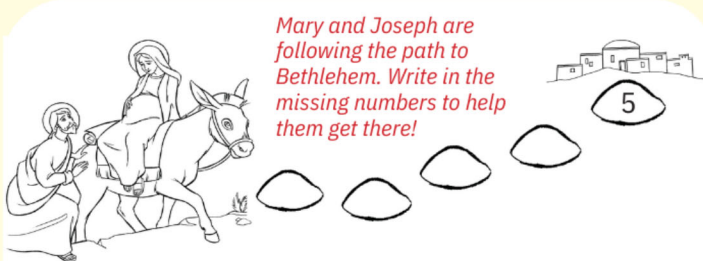

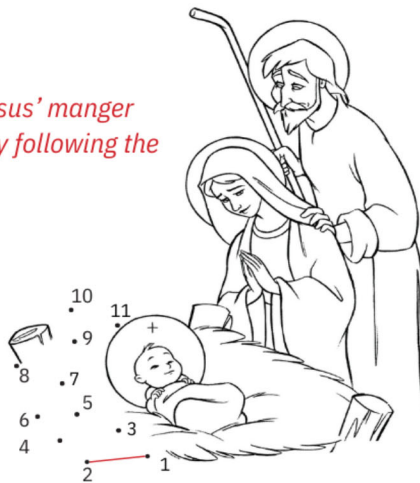

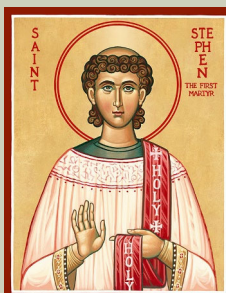

26 de diciembre: San Esteban



- ◆ Primer mártir
- ◆ Fue uno de los siete discípulos varones que eligieron actuar como diácono y atender las necesidades de las viudas.
- ◆ Fue apedreado hasta la muerte y clamó: "Señor, no les tomes en cuenta este pecado" y "Padre, perdónalos porque no saben lo que hacen" (Lucas 23:34)

- ◆ En Inglaterra, el Día de San Esteban se conoce como el día de la caja:

El nombre proviene de la tradición de guardar dinero durante todo el año en una caja y luego abrir la caja después de Navidad y dar limosna a los necesitados. Considere dar obsequios, ya sea monetarios, ropa, otros bienes, y una organización benéfica.

Rincón del Párroco—Teología del Cuerpo (6)



¿La decisión es moral o inmoral, esterilizar deliberadamente el acto matrimonial a través de algún medio anticonceptivo, o abortar la nueva vida en el útero porque el embarazo es una carga? La razón por la que relaciono la cuestión de la moralidad de la anticoncepción y el aborto es porque la experiencia vivida por muchas personas es que, si falla el “sexo seguro” mediante la anticoncepción, entonces el aborto puede estar justificado.

En la decisión de la Corte Suprema de 1992 llamada *Planned Parenthood v. Casey*, el juez Kennedy declaró: “Durante dos décadas de desarrollo económico y social, las personas han organizado relaciones íntimas y han tomado decisiones que definen sus puntos de vista sobre sí mismas y su lugar en la sociedad, basándose en la disponibilidad del aborto en caso de que falle la anticoncepción”.

Pero, ¿son morales las decisiones de anticoncepción o abortar, es decir, están de acuerdo con la Verdad y el Amor de Dios? El juez Kennedy continuó escribiendo: “En el corazón de la libertad está el derecho a definir el propio concepto de existencia, de significado, del universo y del misterio de la vida humana”. ¡Les presento que esta declaración es un esfuerzo por establecer el estado de Pecado Original como un derecho humano! La profesora de filosofía, Janet Smith, comenta

lo siguiente: “Este pasaje refleja el individualismo y el escepticismo que conduce al relativismo. Sugiere que no hay significado para la realidad que todos debemos descubrir y vivir; más bien establece que debemos ser libres para definir, no para descubrir, sino para definir, el significado de la existencia”. (El Derecho a la Privacidad, por Janet E. Smith, p. 52). En otras palabras, el juez Kennedy, hablando en nombre de la cultura secular dominante, está afirmando el “derecho” de los seres humanos a actuar como sus propios dioses, es decir, a determinar por sí mismos lo que es bueno y lo que es malo, lo que es moral y lo que es inmoral, sin respeto a ninguna autoridad superior.

Como discípulos de Jesucristo, quien es el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida, estamos siendo capacitados para ser testigos del significado dado por Dios a la vida humana, a la sexualidad humana, al matrimonio y la familia humana. La Teología del Cuerpo de San Juan Pablo II puede guiarnos a una comprensión profunda de estos significados. TOB puede ayudarnos a apreciar y celebrar el asombroso significado de la Encarnación y el Nacimiento de Jesús. ¡Feliz Navidad! (Más por venir).

The Catholic Church celebrates the Birth of Our Lord with an entire liturgical season which begins with the Vigil Mass on Christmas Eve and continues through the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord in January. Have a very merry Christmas Season!



LA NAVIDAD ES UN TIEMPO LITÚRGICO

El 25 de diciembre es el primer día de Navidad.
