Pastor's Corner

Sr. Lucia, at age 77, who continued to receive visits from our Lady, sent this message to the Vatican in 1984: "The final battle between the Lord and the reign of Satan will be about marriage and the family." Jesus offers us his Victory in this battle by offering us Himself. He equips us with the weapons of Truth and Love. To make us more aware of the Truth of being created in the image of Divine Love, my next series of Pastor's Corners will focus on the brilliance of Truth and Love found in St. Paul VI's 1968 Encyclical, ON HUMAN LIFE and the 1979-1984 teaching of St. John Paul II known as THEOLOGY OF THE BODY.

IT'S WAR! The world, the flesh and the devil are trying to pull us away from God and into the darkness at all times. If we forget we are in a war and cease being vigilant, we will lose. It really helps to prayerfully focus on the TRUTH and LOVE revealed in JESUS at the beginning of each day. Here is an example of how I try to put this into practice in my daily morning prayer.

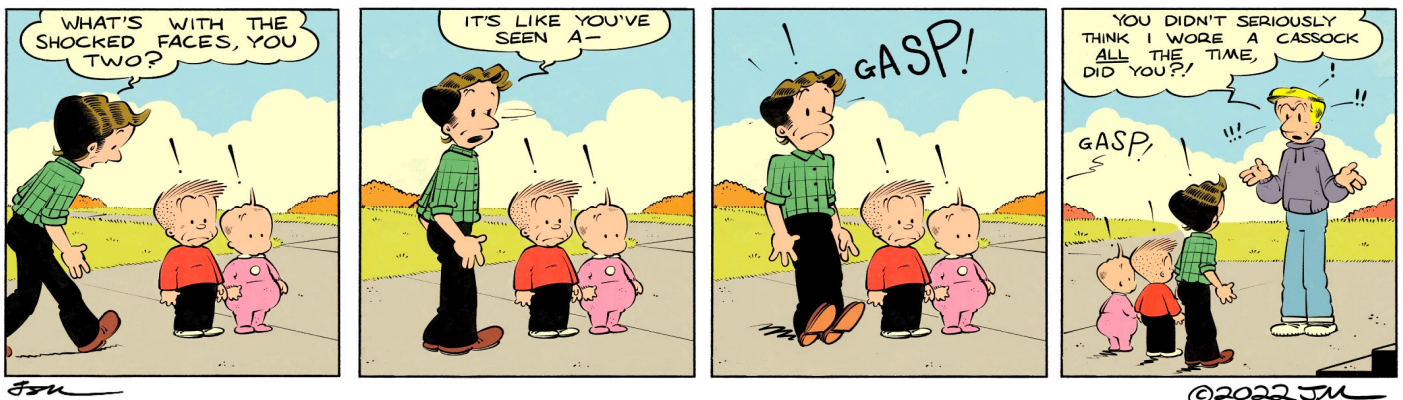

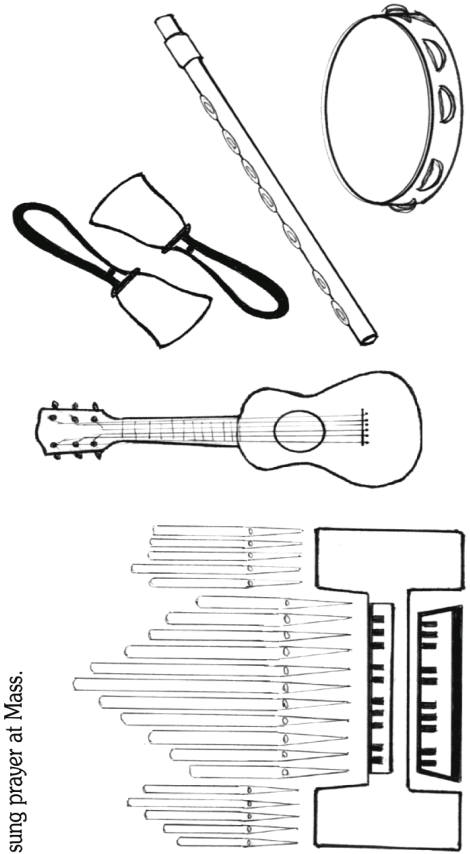
PRAYING TWICE

The Academy of Music (Accademia Nazionale di Santa Cecilia) was founded in Rome by Pope Sixtus V in 1585. Named for St. Cecilia, it was established under the invocation of the Blessed Virgin; Pope St. Gregory I, credited as the author of Gregorian chant; and St. Cecilia, the patron saint of music and musicians. The Academy's first location was the Church of Santa Maria ad Martyres, also known as the Pantheon. You can see pictures of its beautiful auditorium online.

On November 22 we remember St. Cecilia. Many choirs and music societies are named in honor of St. Cecilia and look to her as their patron. What is your favorite hymn to sing with the choir?

St. Augustine said, "The one who sings prays twice." What do you think he meant?

You might hear some of these instruments in a church. Color the ones that you have heard in your parish. Choose one to draw on the front of a card. Inside, write a note to the director of your choir describing how much you appreciate the music they provide. You can present your card to the choir directly after Mass one day or send it to your parish office. Remember, you are a member of the Church and so are responsible—with the choir or cantor—for much of the sung prayer at Mass.
