Pastor's Corner

Humanae Vitae and Theology of the Body (1)



Pope Paul VI

If a married couple has a good and responsible reason for avoiding pregnancy, is it moral to use modern technology through barrier methods, a withdrawal method, or through hormonal- chemical methods (the pill, the shot, the patch, the IUD, etc.) to achieve that end?

Pope Paul VI formed a committee of experts to help him formulate a response to these questions. His response would need to bring the Wisdom, Love and Truth of Divine Revelation to bear on these age-old questions. These questions were given fresh relevance through advances in modern technology. In 1968, prior to Pope Paul VI's publication of his Encyclical - on Human life - (Humanae Vitae in Latin), the majority opinion of the committee was leaked to the Press. The majority opinion stated that under certain conditions, it was moral to deliberately sterilize the marriage act; that these decisions were in accord with human dignity and human freedom.



Rene Descartes

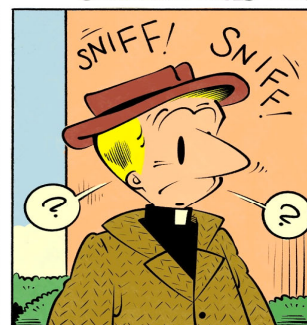
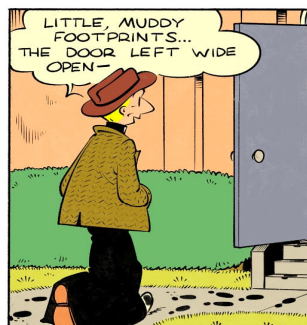
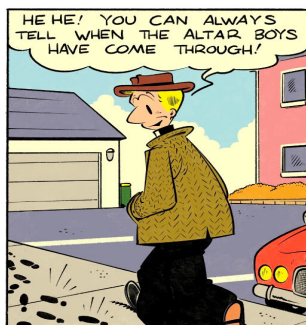
One of the main influences on this majority opinion was a relatively modern philosophical understanding on what it means to be a human being. Rene Descartes, a French Catholic philosopher (1596-1650), had posited, "I think, therefore I am." Descartes saw the power of human reason as the essence of human nature. The human body was reckoned as so much "matter" which could be used and subjugated by human reason.

Aside from a majority opinion, out of a dualistic philosophy that lends itself to relativism, our most important questions in the Pastor's Corners ahead will focus on **the Truth of the God-given meaning of human dignity, human sexuality, the human body – male and female, human marriage and family.**

Humanae Vitae y Teología del Cuerpo (1)



Pope Paul VI

Si una pareja casada tiene una razón buena y responsable para evitar el embarazo, ¿es moral utilizar la tecnología moderna a través de métodos de barrera, abstinencia, hormonales-químicos (la píldora, la inyección, el parche, el DIU, etc.) para lograr ese fin?

El Papa Pablo VI formó un comité de expertos para ayudarlo a formular una respuesta a estas preguntas. Su respuesta necesitaría traer la Sabiduría, el Amor y la Verdad de la Revelación Divina para responder a estas antiguas preguntas. A estas preguntas se les dio una nueva relevancia a través de los avances en la tecnología moderna. En 1968, antes de la publicación de la Encíclica del Papa Pablo VI -sobre la vida humana- (Humanae Vitae en latín), se filtró a la prensa la opinión mayoritaria del comité. La opinión mayoritaria afirmó que, bajo ciertas condiciones, era moral esterilizar deliberadamente el acto matrimonial; que estas decisiones estaban de acuerdo con la dignidad humana y la libertad humana.



Rene Descartes

Una de las principales influencias en esta opinión mayoritaria fue una comprensión filosófica relativamente moderna de lo que significa ser un ser humano. René Descartes, un filósofo católico francés (1596-1650), había postulado: “Pienso, luego existo”. Descartes vio el poder de la razón humana como la esencia de la naturaleza humana. El cuerpo humano se consideraba como tanta “materia” que podía ser utilizada y subyugada por la razón humana.

Aparte de una opinión mayoritaria, a partir de una filosofía dualista que se presta al relativismo, nuestras preguntas más importantes en el Rincón del Párroco que se aproximan se centrarán en **la Verdad del significado dado por Dios a la dignidad humana, la sexualidad humana, el cuerpo humano: masculino y femenino, matrimonio humano y familia.**
