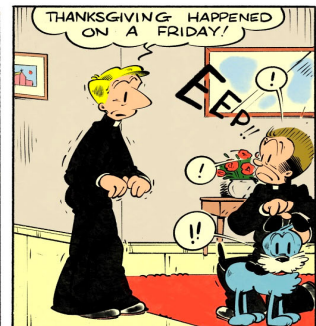
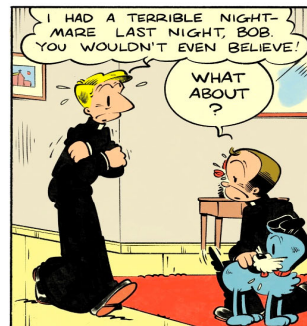
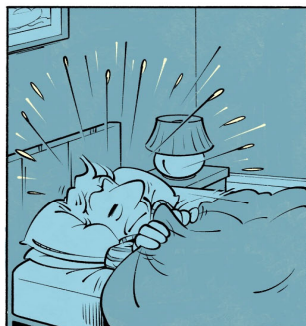


Pope Benedict XVI

“Mary experienced the most powerful erotic desires of any woman who ever walked on our planet.” Christopher West used this statement to grab my attention in his keynote address at the 50th Anniversary of Humanae Vitae Conference, Ontario, CA, July 28, 2018. He went on to say that, “We tend to associate “Erotic love” with pornography. Whereas, Eros is given to us by God to launch us toward the stars and beyond. Pope Benedict XVI says that Eros is our desire for God; a desire for every infinite of Truth, Goodness, Love and Beauty. Original sin inverted the rocket engines of Eros. They are now aimed at finite pleasures. Christ came into the world, not to condemn those with inverted rocket engines, but to re-direct those rocket engines. Redemption begins with Eros. Jesus’ first miracle/sign, at a wedding in Cana of Galilee, is meant to show us that he came to restore Agape (Divine Love) to Eros (the Love of Need and Desire). Jesus came to help us become intoxicated with God’s Wine of Agape/Eros.”
