PASTOR'S CORNER

OUR LADY'S PEACE PLAN (13)

The Second Secret: War, Communism and the Immaculate Heart of Mary

World War I began in the Summer of 1914 and lasted until November 11, 1918. . . . It was the deadliest war the world had ever seen, killing about twenty million people. . . . As it turned out, the treaty at the end of the war was harsh and oppressive to the Central Powers and laid the groundwork for an even more terrible conflict.

Pray, Especially the Rosary

Our Lady said that lasting peace could only come about if certain conditions were met. One of them, as we have already seen, was prayer, especially the Rosary. . . . Remember Saint Augustine's words: "God made us without us, but he will not save us without us." We must do our part. We must choose to offer prayers and sacrifices for the gift of peace in the world. . . . Peace in the world must begin with peace in the human heart. . . . Jesus gave this gift to the disciples at the Last Supper when he said: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you." (Jn 14:27). The peace of God keeps us focused on reality, and God is the greatest Reality!. . . . The person with God's peace knows that everything in this world and everything in our personal lives are guided by God's divine wisdom and providence.

A Worse War Will Come

In World War II about fifty million people were killed, and there were many more atrocities visited upon civilians, especially the Jews. . . . Our Lady's warning is as meaningful now as it was in 1917. We know that the superpowers of the world have huge stockpiles of horrible weapons. . . . Our Blessed Lady has the plan for peace, so we do not have to invent another one. We only have to put her plan into practice.

An Evil in Russia – Communism

In the 1917 Communist Revolution in Russia, led by Lenin and continued under Stalin, religious instruction was outlawed and materialism and atheism were taught to the young in schools. . . . The traditional family was no longer respected as the fundamental building block of society, but regarded as a source of oppression and a rival to the authority of the state. Russia took over its neighbors and became the Soviet Union. Revolution brought Communists to power in China, in Cuba, in Viet Nam and North Korea. . . . During the first fifty years of Communist ascendancy, there were more Christian martyrs than there were in all the previous years of Christian history combined! . . . Meanwhile atheistic secularism is spreading throughout Japan, Western Europe, North America and beyond. . . . Mary's promise of the Triumph of Her Immaculate Heart is like a beacon of hope in the midst of the spiritual amid moral darkness of our age.

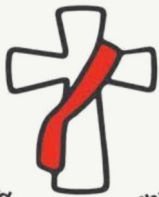

Verdad una Guerra Peor

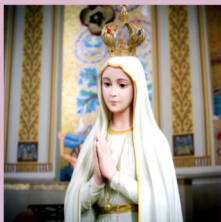

Un mal en Rusia - Comunismo

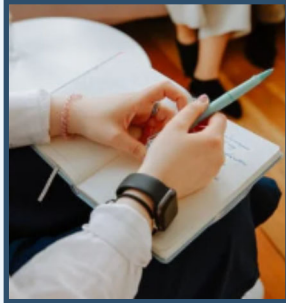
