PASTOR'S CORNER



OUR LADY'S PEACE PLAN (14)

Communion of Reparation and Consecration of Russia
Many of the social problems we face today can be traced to the growing secularism in our society, which is related to the anti-Christian ideology that took root in Russia and then spread around the world. Materialism, with its rejection of God and the freedom to worship him; and the rejection of the traditional family, is the basis of the aggressive secularism we are experiencing.

On December 10, 1925, our Lady and the Christ Child appeared to Lucia in her room at the Dorothean convent and requested the Five First Saturdays devotion. Jesus and Mary asked that on the first Saturdays of five consecutive months we go to confession, receive Holy Communion, say a Rosary and then meditate for fifteen minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary. All of these are to be done with the intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary for the many sins and blasphemies by which she is offended. Mary promised that she will assist at the moment of death, with all the graces necessary for salvation, every person who makes this devotion. The Christ Child stressed, however, that we should not make this devotion only once, but make it over and over again. Our Lord and his holy mother want and even need our ongoing prayers and sacrifices for the conversion of sinners and the promotion of world peace.

On June 13, 1929, Sr. Lucia saw a magnificent vision of the Most Holy Trinity and our Blessed Lady. It is important to mention our Lady's request on that occasion: The moment has come in which God asks the Holy father, in union with all the Bishops of the world, to make the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, promising to save it by this means.

Unfortunately, various factors contributed to delaying the consecration of Russia to Mary's Immaculate Heart.

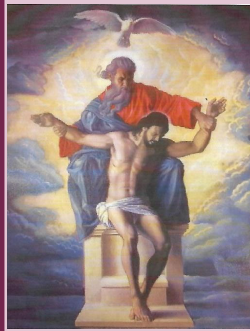

SACRIFICIAL GIVING



In order for our Capital Campaign to succeed, we are all going to have to consider making a Sacrificial Pledge toward the building of our new Holy Trinity Catholic Church. Before we can determine what our Sacrificial Pledge will be, we must first understand what a sacrifice is, and what sacrificial giving is. Only then will be able to determine if what we are committing to is sacrificial in nature. **Sacrificial love is love that gives until it**

hurts. God the Father asked His Son to be tortured by our sins and sacrificed on the cross so that all poor sinners, from Adam and Eve to the end of time, could hear Jesus pray, “Father, forgive them; they know not what they do.” The Father’s sacrificial response was to send His Risen Son back to the world with the words, “Shalom – Peace be with you; as the Father has sent me, now I send you; Receive the Holy Spirit!” This unimaginable Sacrificial Love, and Self-Gift of the Father and Jesus, is what heals the wound of Original Sin, which is our lack of trust in God. **This Sacrificial Self-Gift of Divine Merciful Love can empower each of us for sacrificial giving in a way that advances God’s Kingdom on Earth.** God the Father and Jesus are ready to establish their Kingdom in our hearts. As Jesus’ disciples, we are empowered and privileged, to be ambassadors of God’s Mercy and to make disciples of as many as we can; baptizing them in the Name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit; and into Jesus’ Victory over sin, death and the devil.

Hence, there is the pressing need to build Holy Trinity Catholic Church in Madera. Thus, more and more disciples can be brought into intimate Communion with the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. So what are we being called to do in this Capital Campaign? We are being asked to pledge an amount that is sacrificial in nature for the expansion of God’s Kingdom here on earth. The quantity will be different for each of us depending on our financial circumstances, but our level of sacrifice can be the same. If after praying about it and reviewing our personal budgets, we decide an amount that we are comfortable with and can easily make, then, while nice, it is not yet sacrificial in nature. We must also be careful not to go to the other extreme and pledge so much that, if we honor the pledge, we will be depriving our family of their basic needs. A Sacrificial Pledge is one where we give more than from what is left over in our monthly budget. Sacrificial giving is redoing our monthly budget and determining; what can we eliminate or “give up for the betterment of others”, from our monthly expenses? For example, do we really need to go out to dinner or drinks with family or friends so many times per month, or, do we really need to buy that newest version of smartphone when our existing phone works just fine. Do we really need those new clothes when we still have a closet full of clothes, etc.? By giving up or sacrificing those desires, which are not critical things in our lives, and adding that savings to what we were planning on giving from what was left in our budget; then we will be giving sacrificially. Only you can determine what that amount is; but pray to the Holy Spirit to give you guidance to truly see what amount of Sacrifice you will be able to give. God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ have already sacrificed for us; what will your response be?

La Comunión Reparadora y la consagración de Rusia. Todo esto había de hacer con la intención de hacer reparación al Corazón Inmaculado de María por los muchos pecados y blasfemias con los que se la ofende. María prometió que ayudaría al momento de la muerte, con todas las gracias necesarias para la salvación, a toda persona que hiciera esa devoción. Sin embargo, el niño Jesús enfatizó que esa devoción había de hacerse, o una sola vez, sino repetirse una y otra vez. 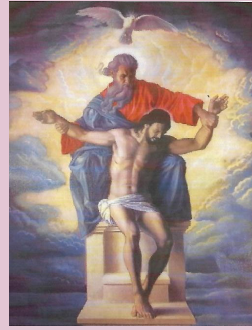

DONACIONES SACRIFICIALES



Para que nuestra Campaña capital tenga éxito, todos vamos a tener que considerar hacer una Promesa Sacrificial para la construcción de nuestra nueva Iglesia Católica de la Santísima Trinidad.

Antes de que podamos determinar cuál será nuestro Compromiso Sacrificial, primero debemos entender qué es un sacrificio y qué es dar sacrificialmente. Sólo entonces podremos determinar si a lo que nos estamos comprometiendo es de naturaleza sacrificial. El amor sacrificial es el amor que da hasta que duele.

Dios Padre permitió que Su Hijo que fuera torturado por nuestros pecados y sacrificado en la cruz para que todos los pobres pecadores, desde Adán y Eva hasta el fin de los tiempos, pudieran escuchar a Jesús orar: “Padre, perdónalos; no saben lo que hacen”. La respuesta sacrificial del Padre fue enviar a Su Hijo Resucitado de regreso al mundo con las palabras: “Shalom – La paz sea contigo; como el Padre me ha enviado, ahora yo te envío a ti; ¡Recibe el Espíritu Santo!” Este inimaginable Amor Sacrificial, y Auto-Don del Padre y Jesús, es lo que sana la herida del Pecado Original, que es nuestra falta de confianza en Dios. Este Auto-Don Sacrificial del Amor Misericordioso Divino puede empoderarnos a cada uno de nosotros para dar sacrificialmente de una manera que promueva el Reino de Dios en la Tierra. Dios Padre y Jesús están listos para establecer su Reino en nuestros corazones. Como discípulos de Jesús, tenemos el poder y el privilegio de ser embajadores de la Misericordia de Dios y de hacer discípulos de tantos como podamos; bautizarlos en el Nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo; y en la Victoria de Jesús sobre el pecado, la muerte y el diablo.

Por lo tanto, existe la necesidad apremiante de construir la Iglesia Católica de la Santísima Trinidad en Madera. Así, más y más discípulos pueden ser llevados a la íntima Comunión con el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo. Entonces, ¿qué estamos llamados a hacer en esta Campaña Capital? Se nos pide que prometamos una cantidad que sea de naturaleza sacrificial para la expansión del Reino de Dios aquí en la tierra. La cantidad será diferente para cada uno de nosotros dependiendo de nuestras circunstancias financieras, pero nuestro nivel de sacrificio puede ser el mismo. Si después de orar al respecto y revisar nuestros presupuestos personales, decidimos una cantidad con la que nos sentimos cómodos y podemos hacer fácilmente, entonces, aunque agradable, aún no es de naturaleza sacrificial. También debemos tener cuidado de no ir al otro extremo y prometer tanto que, si honramos la promesa, estaremos privando a nuestra familia de sus necesidades básicas.

Un Compromiso de Sacrificio es aquel en el que damos más de lo que sobra en nuestro presupuesto mensual. Dar sacrificialmente es rehacer nuestro presupuesto mensual y determinar; ¿qué podemos eliminar o “renunciar por el mejoramiento de los demás”, de nuestros gastos mensuales? Por ejemplo, ¿realmente necesitamos salir a cenar o tomar algo con la familia o los amigos tantas veces al mes, o realmente necesitamos comprar esa versión más nueva de teléfono inteligente cuando nuestro teléfono existente funciona bien? ¿Realmente necesitamos esa ropa nueva cuando todavía tenemos un armario lleno de ropa, etc.? En renunciar o sacrificar esos deseos, que no son cosas críticas en nuestras vidas, y agregar ese ahorro a lo que estábamos planeando dar de lo que quedaba en nuestro presupuesto; entonces estaremos dando sacrificialmente. Solo tú puedes determinar cuál es esa cantidad; pero ora al Espíritu Santo para que te guíe para ver verdaderamente qué cantidad de sacrificio podrás dar. Dios el Padre y nuestro Señor Jesucristo ya se han sacrificado por nosotros; ¿Cuál será su respuesta?

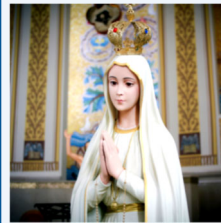
