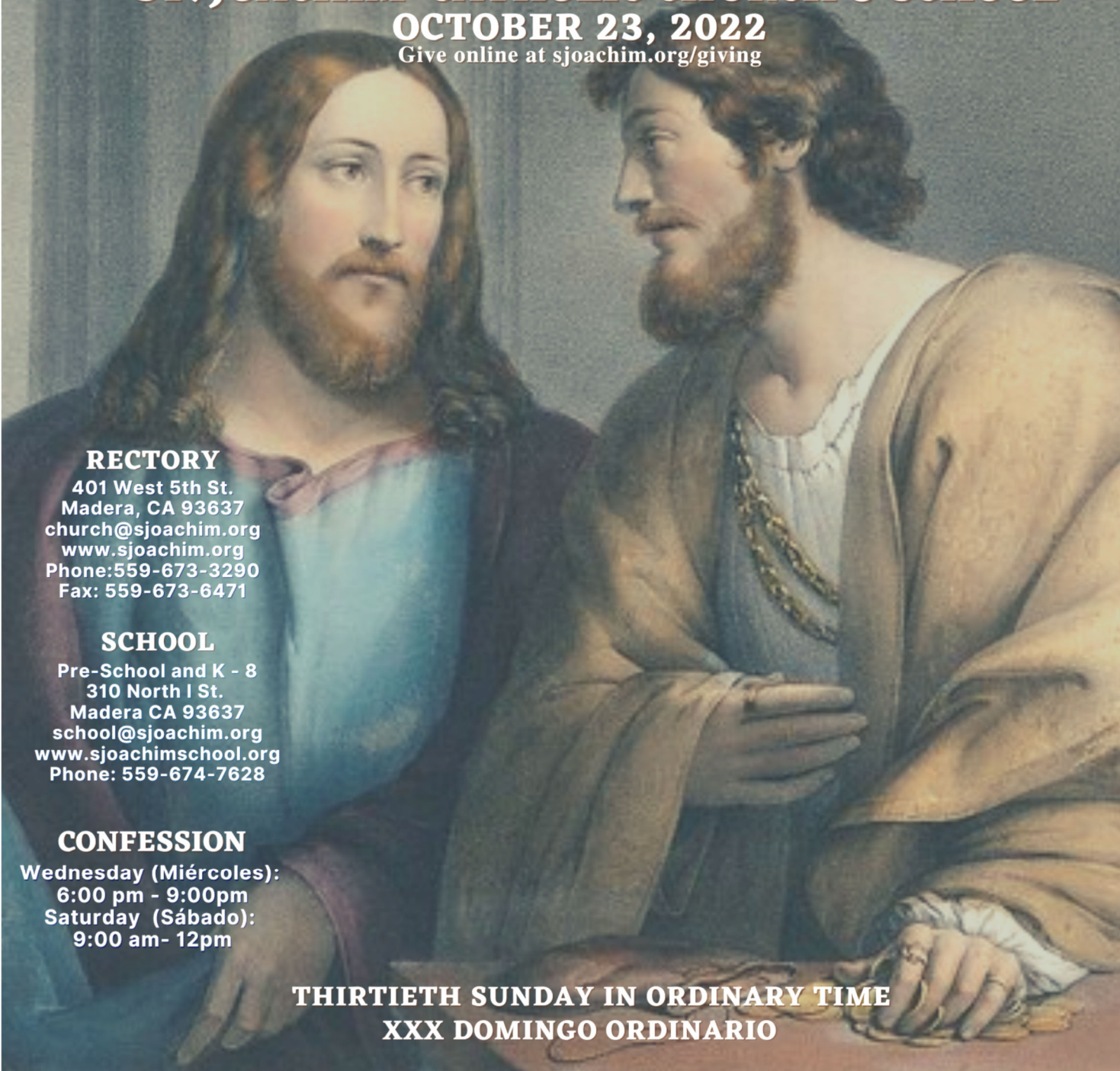

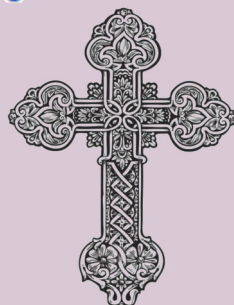

PASTOR'S CORNER

OUR LADY'S PEACE PLAN (16) "Third Secret:" The People Climbing the Mountain

The Third Secret of the July apparition was publicly announced at the Beatification Mass for Francisco and Jacinta on May 13, 2000. In his official commentary on the children's visions, Cardinal Ratzinger wrote, "*The future is not in fact unchangeably set, and the image which the children saw is in no way a film preview of a future in which nothing can be changed. Indeed, the whole point of the vision is to bring freedom onto the scene and to steer freedom in a positive direction.*" Hence, the exclamation of the angel with the flaming sword, "Penance, Penance, Penance!"

Here is Lucia's description of the second part of the Third Secret, taken from the Vatican translation of her handwritten account:

And we saw in an immense light that is God (something similar to how people appear in a mirror when they pass in front of it) a Bishop dressed in White (we had the impression that it was the Holy Father). Other Bishops, Priests, men and women Religious going up a steep mountain, at the top of which there was a big Cross of rough-hewn trunks as of a cork-tree with the bark; before reaching there the Holy Father passed through a big city half in ruins and half trembling with halting step, afflicted with pain and sorrow, he prayed for the corpses he met on his way; having reached the top of the mountain, on his knees at the foot of the big Cross he was killed by a group of soldiers who fired bullets and arrows at him, and in the same way there died one after another the other Bishops, Priests, men and women Religious and various lay people of different ranks and positions.

In his Theological Commentary Cardinal Ratzinger wrote, "*The Church's path is thus described as a Via Crucis [Way of the Cross], as a journey through a time of violence destruction and persecution. ... The entire twentieth century is represented in these images, and through it all the pope had a special role. All the Popes, beginning with Saint Pius X and ending with Saint John Paul II shared the sufferings of the century as they strove to lead the Church, but Pope John Paul II had a particular destiny. (From the book, Fatima for Today, by Fr. Andrew Apostoli, CFR, pp. 87-89). (More to come).*

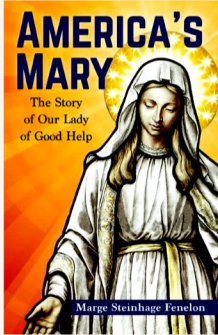

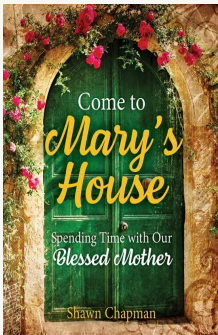

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

El Plan de paz de Nuestra Señora (16) “Tercer Secreto:” La Gente Subiendo la Montaña

El Tercer Secreto de la aparición de julio fue anunciado públicamente en la Misa de Beatificación de Francisco y Jacinta el 13 de mayo de 2000. En su comentario oficial sobre las visiones de los niños, el Cardenal Ratzinger escribió: “ *El futuro está determinado de un modo inmutable, y la imagen que los niños vieron no es una película anticipada del futuro, de la cual nada podría cambiarse toda la visión tiene lugar en realidad solo para llamar la atención sobre la libertad y para dirigirla en una dirección positiva.* ” De ahí la exclamación del ángel con la espada flamígera: “ ¡Penitencia, penitencia, penitencia! ”

Esta es la descripción que da sor Lucía, tomada de la traducción hecha en el Vaticano de su relato manuscrito:

Y vimos en una inmensa luz qué es Dios (algo semejante a como se ven las personas en un espejo cuando pasan ante él) a un Obispo vestido de Blanco (tuvimos el presentimiento que fuera el Santo Padre). También a otros Obispos, sacerdotes, religiosos y religiosas subir una montaña empinada, en cuya cumbre había una gran Cruz de maderos toscos como si fueran de alcornoque con la corteza; el Santo Padre, antes de llegar a ella, atravesó una gran ciudad medio en ruinas y medio tembloroso con paso vacilante, apesadumbrado de dolor y pena, rezando por las almas de los cadáveres que encontraba por el camino; llega a la cima del monte, postrado de rodillas a los pies de la gran Cruz, fue muerto por un grupo de soldados que le dispararon varios tiros de arma de fuego y flechas; y del mismo modo murieron unos tras otros Obispos, sacerdotes, religiosos y religiosas y diversas personas seculares, hombres y mujeres de diversas clases y posiciones.

En su Comentario teológico, el cardenal Ratzinger escribió, “ El camino de la iglesia se describe así como un viacrucis [Camino de la Cruz] como camino en un tiempo de violencia, de destrucciones y de persecuciones.” Agrega que todo el siglo XX está representado en estas imágenes, y que a lo largo de todo eso el papa tuvo un papel especial. A todos los Papas, comenzando con san Pío X para terminar con el papa Juan Pablo II. Todos ellos compartieron los sufrimientos del siglo y se esforzaron por guiar a la Iglesia, pero el papa Juan Pablo II tuvo un destino particular.

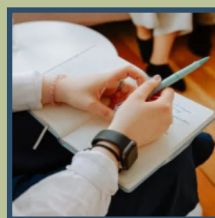
