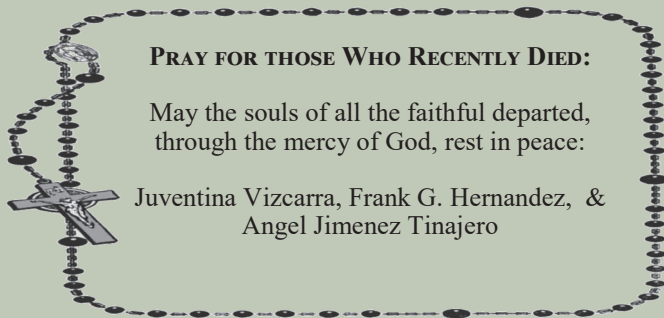

PASTOR'S CORNER

OUR LADY'S PEACE PLAN (9) : June 13, 1917 – Our Lady's Second Apparition at Fatima

Lucia began with her usual question: "What do you want of me?" ...Our Lady repeated her request to pray the Rosary every day. Mary's next request was new: she told Lucia to learn to read. As we will see, it was Lucia's mission to spread our Lady's message from Fatima to the whole world. It was most important, then, for Lucia to learn to read and write. She learned quite successfully. Eventually she even mastered the use of the computer.

Lucia's Request to Go to Heaven

As we already saw in our Lady's first apparition, Lucia asked if the children would go to heaven. This time Lucia asked on behalf of all three visionaries if the Lady would take them there. Our Lady's answer reveals an important part of God's plan:

"Yes, I will take Jacinta and Francisco soon. But you are to stay here some time longer. Jesus wishes to make use of you to make me known and loved. He wants to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart."

These words of our Lady must have caused great joy and sorrow at the same time. They brought joy to Jacinta and Francisco because they longed so much to go to heaven, but for Lucia, our Lady's words brought sorrow. ...When Lucia asked our Lady if she would be alone after her cousins went to heaven, our Lady replied:

"No, my daughter. Are you suffering a great deal? Don't lose heart. I will never forsake you. My Immaculate Heart will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God."

Lucia lived nearly eighty-seven more years from the time God entrusted this mission to her ... Finally, the children saw the heart of our Lady surrounded with piercing thorns, which represented the offenses committed against her. These were the sins that needed reparation, and the children were eager to offer it. (Fatima for Today), by Fr. Andrew Apostoli, CFR, pp. 50 - 54). (More to come.)

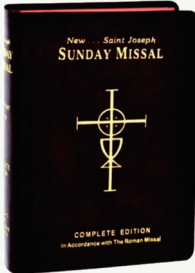

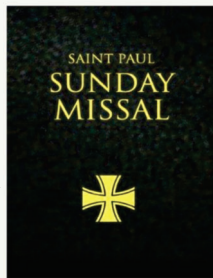

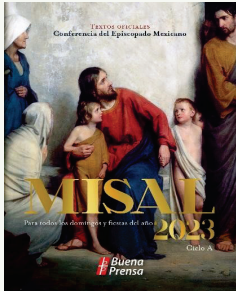

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

EL PLAN DE PAZ DE NUESTRA SEÑORA (9) 13 de junio de 1917 – Segunda aparición de Nuestra Señora en Fátima

Lucía comenzó con su pregunta habitual: “¿Qué quiere usted de mí?” ... Nuestra Señora repitió otras solicitudes que rezaran el Rosario todos los días. La tercera solicitud de María era nueva: le dijo a Lucía que aprendiera a leer. Como veremos, la misión de Lucía era difundir el mensaje de Nuestra Señora desde Fátima hasta el mundo entero. Por eso era importantísimo que Lucía aprendiera a leer y escribir. Y Aprendió con mucho éxito. con el tiempo incluso llegó a dominar el uso de la computadora.

La petición de Lucía de ir al cielo

Como ya vimos en la primera aparición de Nuestra Señora, Lucía preguntó si los niños irían al cielo. Esta vez Lucía preguntó de parte de los tres videntes, si la Señora los llevaría allá. La respuesta de Nuestra Señora revela una parte importante del plan de Dios:

“Sí, a Jacinta y a Francisco me los llevare pronto. Pero tú debes quedarte aquí por un tiempo más. Jesús quiere usarte a ti para hacer que se me conozca y se me ame. Él quiere establecer en el mundo de la devoción a mi Corazón Inmaculado.”

Estas palabras de Nuestra Señora deben de haber causado gran alegría y pesar al mismo tiempo. Alegaron a Jacinta y a Francisco porque ellos tenían un gran anhelo irse al cielo, pero a Lucía, las palabras de Nuestra Señora le causaron dolor... Cuando Lucía le preguntó a Nuestra Señora si ella iba a quedarse sola cuando sus primos fueran al cielo, Nuestra Señora respondió:

“No, hija mía. ¿Estás sufriendo mucho? No te desanimes. yo nunca abandonar Mi Corazón Inmaculado sería tu refugio y será el camino que te llevará a Dios.”

Lucía vivió casi ochenta y siete años más desde del momento en que Dios le confió esta misión... Por último, los niños vieron el corazón de Nuestra Señora rodeado de espinas que lo perforaban, y que representaban las ofensas cometidas contra ella. Esos eran los pecados por los que había que hacer reparación, y los niños estaban deseosos de ofrecerla. (Fátima para Hoy) por el Padre Andrew Apostoli, CFR, pp. 50 - 54). (Más por venir.)
