PASTOR'S CORNER

OUR LADY'S PEACE PLAN (10) July 13, 1917 – Our Lady's Third Apparition at Fatima

Without doubt the appearances of our Lady in July and October of 1917 were the most powerful and important of all the Fatima apparitions. In July our Lady gave the children the core of her message, which blended many serious warnings with a message of hope in the ultimate victory of her Immaculate Heart. In October our Lady provided the miraculous sign by which people would know that the apparitions to the children were real.

In one of his many statements about Our Lady of Fatima, Pope John Paul II said that she summed up the whole twentieth century. In her July apparition, she made reference to some of the most momentous events and movements that shaped the modern world. She spoke of the end of World War I, but warned of another greater war that would happen if people did not heed her call to prayer, penance and amendment of life. She warned of the menace of Communism that would arise in Russia and spread its evil teachings throughout the world, provoking wars and other calamities, especially persecutions of the Catholic Church.

When Lucia later described the July apparition of our Lady, she divided the message into three parts, which she called "secrets." She explained the first two secrets in one of her memoirs on August 31, 1941, and she made some additions to this text on December 8, 1941. She wrote about the Third Secret under the date of January 3, 1944. She stated that she did so "by order of His Excellency, the Bishop of Leira and the Most Holy Mother." On April 4, 1957, the unopened envelope was placed in the secret archives of the Holy Office at the Vatican. This extreme confidentiality led to a great deal of speculation and conjecture. ... The contents of the Third Secret were finally revealed by Pope John II at the Mass of Beatification of Francisco and Jacinta Marto in the Cova da Iria on May 13, 2000. (Fatima for Today, by Fr. 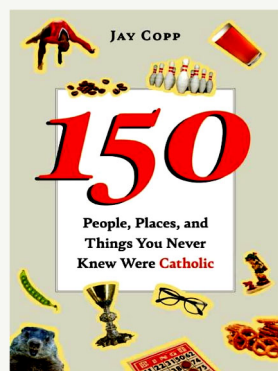
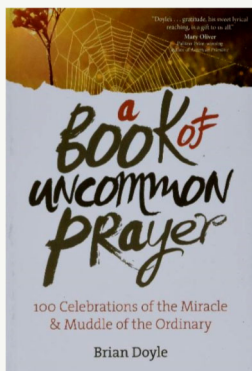

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

EL PLAN DE PAZ DE NUESTRA SEÑORA (10) 13 de Julio, 1917 — La Tercera Aparición de Nuestra Señora de Fátima

Sin duda las apariciones de Nuestra Señora en julio y octubre de 1917 fueron las mas poderosas e importantes de todas las apariciones de Fátima. En julio, Nuestra Señora les dio a los niños su mensaje fundamental, que cambio muchas advertencias serias con un mensaje de esperanza en la victoria final de su Inmaculado Corazón. En octubre , Nuestra Señora proporciono la señal milagrosa por lo cual la gente sabría que las apariciones a los niños eran reales.

En una de sus muchas declaraciones sobre Nuestra Señora de Fátima, el Papa Juan Pablo II dijo que ella resumía todo el siglo (veinte) XX . En su aparición de julio, hizo referencia a algunos de los eventos y movimientos mas memorables que dieron forma al mundo moderno. Habló del final de la Primera Guerra Mundial, pero advirtió de otra guerra mayor que sucedería si la gente no escuchaba su llamado a la oración, la penitencia y la Enmienda de la vida. Nuestra Señora advirtió de la amenaza del comunismo que surgiría en Rusia y esparciría sus malas enseñanzas por todo el mundo, provocando guerras y otras calamidades, especialmente persecuciones a la Iglesia Católica.

Cuando Lucía describió más tarde la aparición de la Virgen en julio, Nuestra Señora dividió el mensaje en tres partes, a las que llamó “secretos”. Explicó los dos primeros secretos en una de sus memorias el 31 de agosto de 1941, e hizo algunas adiciones a este texto el 8 de diciembre de 1941. Nuestra Señora escribió sobre el Tercer Secreto con fecha del 3 de enero de 1944. Dijo que Ella lo hizo “por orden de Su Excelencia, el Obispo de Leira y de la Santísima Madre”. El 4 de abril de 1957, el sobre sin abrir fue colocado en los archivos secretos del la Oficina Santa en el Vaticano. Esta extrema confidencialidad condujo a una gran cantidad de especulaciones y conjeturas. ... El contenido del Tercer Secreto fue finalmente revelado por el Papa Juan II en la Misa de Beatificación de Francisco y Jacinta Marto en Cova da Iria el 13 de mayo de 2000.
