PASTOR'S CORNER

TOGETHER WE BUILD ... HOLY TRINITY CATHOLIC CHURCH



We propose to have devotional shrines in Holy Trinity Catholic Church; one honoring The Cristero martyrs and another, young saints. The painting on the side, now at the old Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City, will be reproduced for our new church. 22 priests and 3 laymen were canonized by Pope John Paul II on May 21, 2000. They were executed by the Mexican government between 1917 and 1929 for disobeying the law that suppressed the celebration of the Church's Sacraments.



One of the martyrs to be included in both shrines is San Jose Sanchez del Rio, age 14. He was canonized by Pope Francis on October 16, 2016. "José was captured by government forces, who ordered him to renounce his faith in Christ, under threat of death. He refused. In prison, José prayed the Rosary daily and wrote an emotional letter to his mother, saying that he was ready to fulfill the will of God to whom he dedicated himself. Others recalled the gruesome events that

transpired after the government's failure to break José's resolve. "On the evening of February 10, 1928, they cut the bottom of his feet and obliged him to walk around the town toward the cemetery. They also at times cut him with a machete until he was bleeding from several wounds. He cried and moaned with pain, but he did not give in. At times they stopped him and said, 'If you shout, "Death to Christ the King" we will spare your life'. José would only shout, 'I will never give in. Viva Cristo Rey!'"[3](Wikipedia).

As our parish celebrates the Solemnity of Pentecost, we recall the words of Christ, "**You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you and you will be my witnesses (Acts 1:8)**. In Latin, the word for "witness" is "martyr." All of us, all baptized and confirmed disciples, are called and empowered by God to be witnesses of His Life, His Love, His Truth, His Justice, His Mercy and His Beauty. We need to be ready to be martyrs. As our culture becomes more and more secular, that is, "Godless," Christ and His Church will be more and more persecuted. Already, much of the Church's moral teaching on the God-given meaning of the dignity of human life, from the moment of conception to natural death, of the meaning of human sexuality, sexual pleasure, the marriage act, marriage and family, are being labeled as "hate speech" by many voices in social media, mass media and by politicians. Children in the womb are paying a terrible price in this "love without truth" culture. And all those outside the womb, young and old, are paying a terrible price. Sin pulls us away from God who is our source of happiness, peace and joy. Sin is its own punishment. Sin makes us miserable.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO
JUNTOS CONSTRUIMOS ... LA IGLESIA CATOLICA DE LA SANTISIMA TRINIDAD



Proponemos tener santuarios devocionales en la Iglesia Católica de la Santísima Trinidad; uno en honor a los mártires cristeros y otro, a los santos jóvenes. La pintura de arriba, ahora se encuentra en la antigua Basílica de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe en la Ciudad de México, será una réplica para nuestra nueva iglesia. 22 sacerdotes y 3 laicos fueron canonizados por el Papa Juan Pablo II el 21 de mayo de 2000. Fueron ejecutados por el gobierno mexicano entre 1917 y 1929 por desobedecer la ley que suprimía la celebración de los Sacramentos de la Iglesia.



En uno de los mártires será incluido en ambos santuarios cual San José Sánchez del Río, de 14 años. Fue canonizado por el Papa Francisco el 16 de octubre de 2016. “José fue capturado por fuerzas gubernamentales, quienes le ordenaron renunciar a su fe en Cristo, bajo amenaza de muerte, el se negó. En prisión, José rezaba el Rosario diariamente y le escribía una carta emocional a su madre, diciéndole que estaba listo para cumplir la voluntad de Dios a quien el se dedicaba. Otros recordaron los espantosos eventos que ocurrieron después de que el gobierno no logró quebrantar la determinación de José. “En la tarde del 10 de febrero de 1928, le cortaron la planta de los pies y lo obligaron a caminar por el pueblo hacia el cementerio. También lo cortaron en ocasiones con un machete hasta dejarlo sangrando por varias heridas. Lloraba y gemía de dolor, pero no cedía. A veces lo detenían y le decían: 'Si gritas: "Muerte a Cristo Rey" te perdonamos la vida'. José solo gritaba: 'Yo nunca me rendiré. ¡Viva Cristo Rey!'” [3 (Wikipedia).

Mientras nuestra parroquia celebra la Solemnidad de Pentecostés, recordamos las palabras de Cristo: “Sino que recibiréis la fuerza del Espíritu Santo, que vendrá sobre vosotros, y seréis mis testigos” (Hechos 1:8). En latín, la palabra para "testigo" es "mártir". Todos nosotros, todos los discípulos bautizados y confirmados, somos llamados y empoderados por Dios para ser testigos de Su Vida, Su Amor, Su Verdad, Su Justicia, Su Misericordia y Su Belleza. Tenemos que estar preparados para ser mártires. A medida que nuestra cultura se vuelva más y más secular, es decir, “sin Dios”, Cristo y Su Iglesia serán más y más perseguidos. Mucha de la enseñanza moral de la Iglesia sobre el significado dado por Dios a la dignidad de la vida humana, desde el momento de la concepción hasta la muerte natural, sobre el significado de la sexualidad humana, el placer sexual, el acto matrimonial, el matrimonio y la familia, ya está siendo etiquetado como “discurso de odio” por muchas voces en las redes sociales, los medios de comunicación y por los políticos. Los niños en el útero están pagando un precio terrible en esta cultura de “amor sin verdad”. Y todos los que están fuera del útero, jóvenes y viejos, están pagando un precio terrible. El pecado nos aleja de Dios quien es nuestra fuente de felicidad, paz y gozo. El pecado es su propio castigo. El pecado nos hace miserables.
