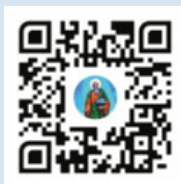

EUCCHARISTIC REVIVAL (13)

THE EUCHARIST IS ALSO THE SACRIFICE OF THE CHURCH.



CCC 1368. ... The Church which is the Body of Christ participates in the offering of her head. With him, she herself is offered whole and entire. She unites herself to his intercession to the Father for all men. In the Eucharist the sacrifice of Christ becomes also the sacrifice of the members of his Body. The lives of the faithful, their praise, sufferings, prayer and work, are united with those of Christ and with his total offering, and so acquire a new value. Christ's sacrifice present on the altar makes it possible for all generations of Christians to be united with his offering.

CCC 1370. To the offering of Christ are united not only the members still here on earth, but also those already in the glory of heaven. In communion with and commemorating the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the saints, the Church offers the Eucharistic sacrifice. In the Eucharist the Church is as it were at the foot of the cross with Mary, united with the offering and intercession of Christ.

CCC 1371. The Eucharistic sacrifice is also offered for the faithful departed who "have died in Christ but are not yet wholly purified," so that they may be able to enter into the light and peace of Christ.

May the Easter-Pentecost-Gift of the Holy Spirit enlighten our minds and inflame our hearts! May the Spirit heighten our awareness of the sacrifice and Self-Gift of Jesus to us in the Eucharist! May God's Self-Gift of the Holy Spirit enkindle our response of loving obedience; gratitude and praise; and whole-hearted worship in Spirit and in Truth.

LA EUCARISTÍA ES IGUALMENTE EL SACRIFICIO DE LA IGLESIA.



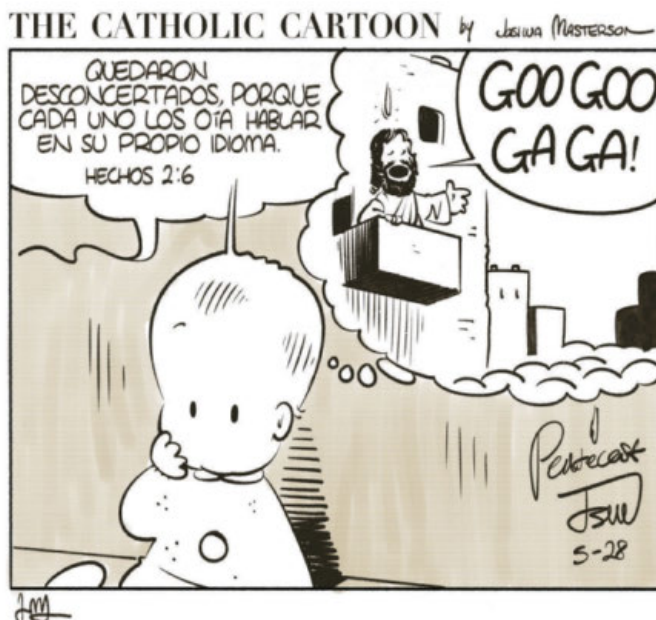
CIC 1368. La Iglesia, que es el cuerpo de Cristo, Participa en la ofrenda de su Cabeza. Con El, ella se ofrece totalmente. Se une a su intercesión ante el Padre por todos los hombres. En la Eucaristía, el sacrificio de Cristo es también el sacrificio de los miembros de su Cuerpo. La vida de los fieles, su alabanza, su sufrimiento, su oración y su trabajo se unen a los de Cristo y a su total ofrenda, y adquieren así un valor nuevo. El sacrificio de Cristo presente sobre el altar da a todas las generaciones de cristianos la posibilidad de unirse a su ofrenda.

CIC 1370. A La ofrenda de Cristo se unen no solo los miembros que están todavía aquí abajo sino también los que están ya en la gloria del cielo: La Iglesia ofrece el sacrificio eucarístico en comunión con la santísima Virgen María y haciendo memoria de ella, así como de todos los santos y santas. CCC 1371. El sacrificio eucarístico es también ofrecido por los fieles difuntos “que han muerto en Cristo y todavía no están plenamente purificados”, para que puedan entrar en la luz y la paz de Cristo:”

¡Que el Don-Pascua-Pentecostés del Espíritu Santo ilumine nuestras mentes y exalte nuestros corazones! ¡Que el Espíritu eleve nuestra conciencia del sacrificio y el Don de sí mismo de Jesús a nosotros en la Eucaristía! Que el Don de sí mismo de Dios en el Espíritu Santo encienda nuestra respuesta de amor con obediencia; gratitud y alabanza; y adoración de todo corazón en Espíritu y Sinceridad.

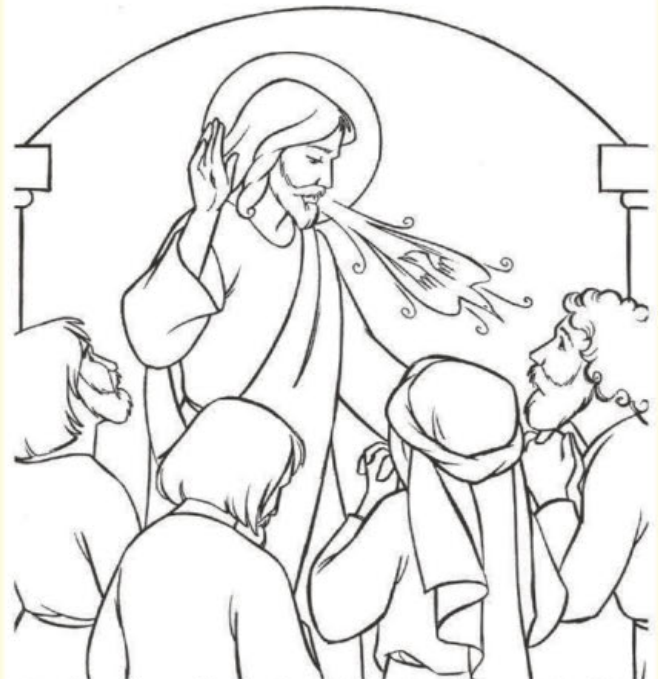
