**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Pope Francis' Invitation (Part Two):** "I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ. I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day" (Joy of the Gospel 3). Last week we were invited to do this by praying the "Lord's Prayer."

**What do we really need? What does God want to give us most of all? The answer is the Gift of Himself. When received, we enter into a Holy Communion with Father, Son and Holy Spirit and with God's people.** This is what Jesus is praying for: "that they may all be one." (Jn. 17:21) There are seven petitions in the Lord's Prayer. Rather than focus on specific graces connected with each petition, it is better to focus on the essence of the entire GIFT God wants to give us. "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son..." (Jn.3:16). Jesus so loved every human being that he laid down his life for us as the Good Shepherd for the forgiveness of our sins, and he rose to give his life to every disciple as the divine Bridegroom. In effect, the words of the Lord's prayer are meant to help us receive the gift of Jesus: **HIS MIND**, his wisdom, his perspective and way of thinking, his truth, his will, his obedience, his trust in the Father; **HIS HEART**, a merciful heart toward all who sin and suffer, his meekness, his compassion for poor sinners; **HIS STRENGTH**, strength to resist all evil and temptation, strength to proclaim his peace and to endure persecution, even martyrdom; and **HIS PROTECTION**, protection from the evil one, and from all demons. In short, we are called to live freely and totally **in Jesus, with Jesus, through Jesus, and for Jesus.** Praying the Lord's Prayer well can help us enter more deeply into this personal encounter with Jesus "at this very moment." (More next week.)

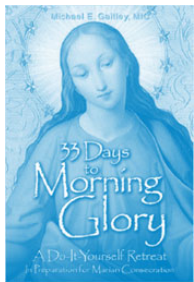

**Invitación del Papa Francisco (Parte Dos):** "Invito a cada cristiano, en cualquier lugar y situación en que se encuentre, a renovar ahora mismo su encuentro personal con Jesucristo o, al menos, a tomar la decisión de dejarse encontrar por Él, de intentarlo cada día sin descanso." (La Alegría del Evangelio 3) La semana pasada nos invitaron a hacer esto rezando el "Padre Nuestro."

**¿Qué es lo que realmente necesitamos? ¿Qué es lo que Dios quiere darnos sobre todo? La respuesta es regalarse Él mismo. Cuando se recibe, entramos en Santa Comunión con el Padre, el Hijo y el Espíritu Santo y con el pueblo de Dios.** Esto es por lo que Jesús está orando: "que todos sean uno." (Jn. 17:21) Hay siete peticiones de la oración del Padre Nuestro. En lugar de enfocarse en las gracias específicas relacionadas con cada petición, es mejor enfocarse en la esencia de todo el REGALO que Dios nos quiere dar. "Tanto amo Dios al mundo que le dio a su Hijo único..." (Jn. 3:16) Jesús amó tanto a cada ser humano que dio su vida por nosotros como Buen Pastor para el perdón de nuestros pecados, y resucitó para dar su vida a cada discípulo como el Novio divino. En efecto, las palabras del Padre Nuestro son para ayudarnos a recibir el don de Jesús: **SU MENTE**, su sabiduría, su perspectiva y forma de pensar, su verdad, su voluntad, su obediencia, su confianza en el Padre; **SU CORAZÓN**, un corazón misericordioso hacia todos los que pecan y sufren, su clemencia, su compasión por los pobres pecadores; **SU FUERZA**, fuerza para resistir toda la maldad y la tentación, fuerza para proclamar su paz y soportar la persecución, incluso el martirio; y **SU PROTECCIÓN**, la protección del maligno, y de todos los demonios. En resumen, estamos llamados a vivir libremente y totalmente **en Jesús, con Jesús, a través de Jesús y por Jesús**. Rezando el Padre Nuestro bien nos puede ayudar a profundizar más este encuentro personal con Jesús "en este preciso momento." (Más la próxima semana.)
