## NOVEMBER 8, 2015

### The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica



Today the Church celebrates the feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome, the oldest and highest ranking of the four major basilicas in Rome. The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the cathedral of the diocese of Rome, the official ecclesiastical seat of the Holy Father, not St. Peter's Basilica as so many mistakenly believe. The Basilica is also called the Church of Holy Savior or the Church of St. John Baptist. In ancient Rome this was the church where everyone was baptized. Built in the time of Constantine and was consecrated by Pope Sylvester in 324. This feast became a universal celebration in honor of the archbasilica, the ecclesiastical mother church, called "the mother and mistress of all churches of Rome and the world", as a sign of love for and union with the See of Peter.

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Pope Francis' Invitation (Part three):** "I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ. I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day" (Joy of the Gospel 3). The Good News is that Jesus takes the initiative in wanting to encounter each of us right where we are and to deepen his friendship with us. His promises are: "Know that I am with you always... (Mt. 28:20); and, "I am standing at the door knocking. If you open the door, I will come in. We will talk and our friendship will grow" (Rev. 3:20).

Last week I recommended praying the Lord's Prayer from your heart as the best way to open the door and invite Jesus in. What then? Once we have welcomed Jesus into our hearts, I recommend that we pray in our own words through the following three steps in a minimum ten-minute, daily, heart to heart, conversation with Jesus. **Step One:** Enter into a moment of deep gratitude and praise for the blessings of creation and redemption you see in your life. **Step Two:** Confide in Jesus your feelings, your difficulties and your needs. Ask for his help. Listen to what he wants to tell you. Try to spend at least three minutes in trustful, expectant listening. **Step Three:** Exercise the power of compassion and charity as you unite your heart to the merciful heart of Jesus and intercede for those you care about; your family, the poor, the sick, the needy, the Church... Since "ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ," (St. Jerome), you may want to prayerfully read a Scripture passage as your diving board into your daily, Lord's Prayer and three-step personal encounter with Jesus.

Thank you for doing this. Your encounter with Jesus enriches all of us.

centers? One organ donor can save up to 8 lives, and one tissue donor can improve the lives of 50 others. But there are too few donors. There are no restrictions to who can sign up to be a donor, even if past disease or certain chronic conditions are present. All major religions support or permit organ and tissue donation. Organs are allocated fairly and based on medical criteria, and there is no cost to the donor or his/her family. Parishioners may become organ and tissue donors by registering on the Donate Life California Organ and Tissue Donor Registry at [www.donateLIFECalifornia.org](http://www.donateLIFECalifornia.org), or by checking "Yes!" the next time you renew your driver license.

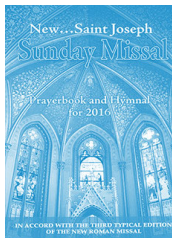
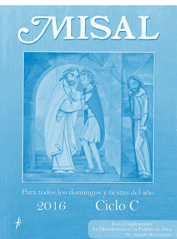
