And Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the LIFE!" (Jn. 11:25); "I am the way, the truth and the LIFE!" (Jn. 14:6); To respect LIFE is to respect JESUS!

St. John Paul II wrote, "A law which violates an innocent person's natural right to life is unjust and, as such, is not valid as law. For this reason I urgently appeal once more to all political leaders not to pass laws which, by disregarding the dignity of the person, undermine the very fabric of society." (Evangelium Vitae, 90).

Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta said, "Any country that accepts abortion is not teaching the people to love but to use any violence to get what they want. That is why the greatest destroyer of love and peace is abortion.

...If we remember that God loves us, and that we can love others as He loves us, then America can become a sign of peace for the world. (Evangelium Vitae, 90).

Beata Madre Teresa de Calcuta dijo: "El país que acepta el aborto no está enseñando a su pueblo a amar sino a aplicar la violencia para conseguir lo que se quiere.
