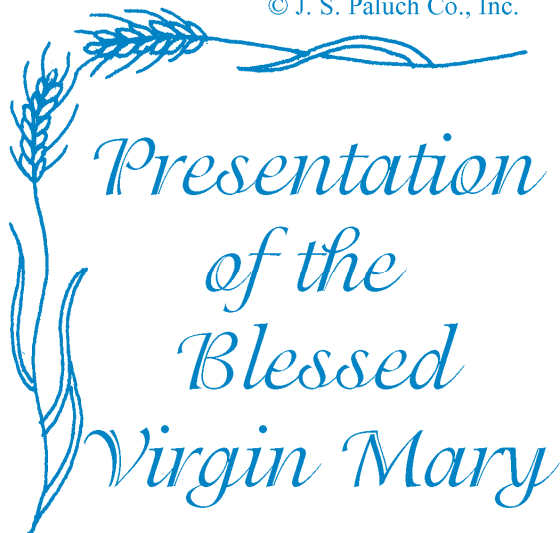

PASTOR'S CORNER

When I was at the World Meeting of Families in Philadelphia at the end of September, I was impressed by how Pastor Rick Warren began his keynote address. This evangelical pastor was specially invited to the WMF by Pope Francis himself. Pastor Warren's memorable diagnosis of what is wrong and what we need to do about it is worth pondering.

"In today's society, materialism is idolized, immorality is glamorized, truth is minimized, sin is normalized, divorce is rationalized, and abortion is legalized. In TV and movies, crime is legitimized, drug use is minimized, comedy is vulgarized, and sex is trivialized. In movies, the Bible is fictionalized, churches are satirized, God is marginalized, and Christians are demonized. The elderly are dehumanized, the sick are euthanized, the poor are victimized, the mentally ill are ostracized, immigrants are stigmatized, and children are tranquilized. In families around the world, our manners are uncivilized, speech is vulgarized, faith is secularized, and everything is commercialized. Christians are often disorganized and demoralized, their faith is compartmentalized, and witness compromised. So what do we need? We need to revitalize our worship, minimize our differences, mobilize our members, and evangelize the lost. And we need to re-energize our families."

How? Accept Pope Francis' invitation: "I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ. I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day." How? Why not try the 33 Days to Morning Glory do-it-yourself retreat, available at the St. Marelllo bookstore?

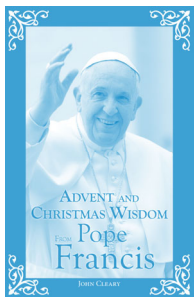
2015-2016 TOGETHER IN FAITH/BISHOPS'S ANNUAL APPEAL

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Invitación del Papa Francisco (Parte Tres): "Invito a cada cristiano, en cualquier lugar y situación en que se encuentre, a renovar ahora mismo su encuentro personal con Jesucristo o al menos, a tomar la decisión de dejarse encontrar por Él, de intentarlo cada día sin descanso." (La Alegría del Evangelio 3) La Buena Nueva es que Jesús toma la iniciativa en querer encontrarse con cada uno de nosotros justo donde estemos y profundizar su amistad con nosotros. Sus promesas son "Y sepan que yo estoy con ustedes todos los días..." (Mt. 28:20); y "Mira que estoy de pie junto a la puerta y llamo. Si alguno oye mi voz y abre la puerta entraré a su casa y cenaré con él y el conmigo." (Rev. 3:20)

La semana antepasada recomendé rezar el Padre Nuestro de corazón como la mejor manera de abrir la puerta e invitar a Jesús. ¿Qué viene después? Una vez que hemos recibido a Jesús en nuestros corazones, les recomiendo que oremos con nuestras propias palabras a través de los tres pasos siguientes con un mínimo de diez minutos, todos los días, de corazón a corazón, conversando con Jesús. **Paso Uno:** Entren en un momento de profunda gratitud y alabanza por las bendiciones de la creación y de redención que puedes ver en tu vida.

Paso Dos: Confíenle a Jesús sus sentimientos, sus dificultades y sus necesidades. Pidan por su ayuda. Escuchen lo que quiere decirles. Traten de pasar por lo menos tres minutos en confianza, escuchando atentamente. **Paso Tres:** Ejercita el poder de la compasión y la caridad cuando unes tu corazón al corazón misericordioso de Jesús e intercede por tus seres queridos; tu familia, los pobres, los enfermos, los necesitados, la Iglesia... Ya que "la ignorancia de las Escrituras es la ignorancia de Cristo," (San Jerónimo), a lo mejor puede ser que desees leer en oración un pasaje de las Escrituras, como tu trampolín al comenzar tu Padre Nuestro, diariamente y los tres pasos de encuentro personal con Jesús.

Gracias por hacer esto. Tu encuentro con Jesús enriquece a todos.
