PASTOR'S CORNER

“There is only one real tragedy in life: not to be a saint.” On this weekend when we celebrate the solemnity of Mary’s bodily Assumption into heaven, we ask the question: what is Mary’s role in God’s plan to bring about holiness in each and every disciple and to get us to heaven? From the cross, Jesus established Mary as the mother of every disciple, the model of the Church and the Queen of all saints. She is the “new Eve,” who by God’s plan provides “the surest, easiest, shortest and most perfect means” to communion with the “new Adam,” Jesus Christ. This expression of truth, “the surest, easiest, shortest and most perfect means” to becoming a saint, was applied to Mary by St. Louis de Montfort in his classic work, True Devotion to Mary. The divine wisdom in de Montfort’s testimony is borne out in the lives of virtually every canonized saint in the last 500 + years. Inspired by St. Louis de Montfort, St. Maximilian Kolbe, Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta, and St. John Paul II, Fr. Michael Gaitley, MIC, was impelled by love to write a remarkable book entitled, 33 Days to Morning Glory, A Do-It-Yourself Retreat In Preparation for Marian Consecration. I cannot recommend this book highly enough. I have made the retreat and the consecration myself. My hope and my prayer is that every parishioner at St. Joachim’s will use this book sooner or later to get on “the quickest, surest, easiest, most perfect path to holiness.” The retreat can be done by any individual with 15 minutes of concentrated effort each morning for 33 days. What was read in the morning can be pondered throughout the day. The retreat can also be made by couples, families, or, together with others who meet once a week during the 33 days. The parish now has two “33 Days” support groups, one in Spanish, and, one in English. Call Francisco (706-1718) for Spanish and Belen (363-8285) for English. RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

"Sólo hay una verdadera tragedia en la vida: no ser un santo." En este fin de semana en que se celebra la solemnidad de la Asunción corporal de María al cielo, nos preguntamos: ¿cuál es el papel de María en el plan de Dios para lograr la santidad en cada uno de los discípulos y para llevarnos al cielo? Desde la cruz, Jesús estableció a María como la madre de todos los discípulos, la modelo de la Iglesia y la Reina de todos los santos. Ella es la "nueva Eva", que según el plan de Dios provee el camino más, "seguro, fácil y corto, y el medio más perfecto" a la comunión con el "nuevo Adán", Jesucristo. Esta expresión de la verdad, "de el camino más seguro, fácil, corto, y el medio más perfecto" para convertirse en un santo, se aplicó a María por San Luis de Montfort en su obra clásica, La Verdadera Devoción a María. La sabiduría divina en el testimonio de Montfort se confirma en las vidas de prácticamente todos los santos canonizados en los últimos 500 años. Inspirado en San Luis de Montfort, San Maximiliano Kolbe, la Beata Madre Teresa de Calcuta, y San Juan Pablo II, el P. Michael Gaitley, MIC, fue impulsado por el amor a escribir un libro notable, titulado 33 Días hacia un Glorioso Amanecer. Un Retiro Personal como Preparación para la Consagración a María. No puedo recomendar este libro lo suficiente. Yo mismo he hecho el retiro y la consagración. Mi esperanza y mi oración es que cada feligrés de San Joaquín usará este libro tarde o temprano para llegar al camino más "seguro, fácil, corto, y el medio más perfecto a la santidad." El retiro se puede hacer por cualquier persona con 15 minutos de concentración cada mañana durante 33 días. Lo que se lee en la mañana se puede meditar durante el día. El retiro también puede hacerse por parejas, familias o, junto con otros que se reúnen una vez a la semana durante los 33 días.
