PASTOR'S CORNER

WORLD MISSION SUNDAY: Through Baptism and Confirmation we are all called and empowered to be missionary disciples. The following quotes are taken from Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation, **The Joy of the Gospel.** "The joy of the Gospel fills the hearts and lives of all who encounter Jesus. In this Exhortation I wish to encourage the Christian faithful to embark upon a new chapter of evangelization marked by this joy (EG 1). I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ. I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day (EG 3). Jesus is the first and the greatest evangelizer. In every activity of evangelization, the primacy always belongs to God, who has called us to cooperate with him who leads us on by the power his Spirit (EG 12). Life grows by being given away, and it weakens in isolation and comfort. Indeed, those who enjoy life most are those who leave security on the shore and become excited by the mission of communicating life to others (EG 10). Christians have the duty to proclaim the Gospel without excluding anyone. Instead of seeming to impose new obligations, Christians should appear as people who wish to share their joy, who point to a horizon of beauty and who invite others to a delicious banquet. It is not by proselytizing that the Church grows, but by attraction (EG 14)."

On this World Mission Sunday, our generosity in the second collection, enables us to participate in a practical way in the Church's effort to bring the Gospel to the ends of the earth; places like Mongolia, Sudan, and the Middle East; and even to the poorest communities in our own Diocese of Fresno.

Las siguientes citas son tomadas de la Exhortación Apostólica del Papa Francisco La Alegría del Evangelio. “La alegría del Evangelio llena el corazón y la vida entera de los que se encuentran con Jesús. En esta Exhortación quiero dirigirme a los fieles cristianos para invitarlos a una nueva etapa evangelizadora marcada por esa alegría.” (EG 1) Invito a cada cristiano, en cualquier lugar y situación en que se encuentre, a renovar ahora mismo su encuentro personal con Jesucristo, de intentarlo cada día sin descanso. (EG 3) Jesús es ‘el primero y el más grande evangelizador’. (EG 12) ‘La vida se acrecienta dándola y se debilita en el aislamiento y la comodidad. No como quien impone una nueva obligación, sino como quien comparte una alegría, señala un horizonte bello, ofrece un banquete deseable. La Iglesia no crece por proselitismo sino ‘por atracción’. (EG 14)”

En este Domingo Mundial de las Misiones, nuestra generosidad en la segunda colecta nos permite participar de una manera práctica en los esfuerzos de la Iglesia para llevar el Evangelio hasta los confines de la tierra; lugares como Mongolia, Sudán, y el Medio Oriente; e incluso a las comunidades más pobres de nuestra Diócesis de Fresno.
