### JUDGED BY MERCY

There are three ways of performing an act of mercy: the merciful word, by forgiving and by comforting; secondly, if you can offer no word, then pray – that too is mercy; and thirdly, deeds of mercy. And when the Last Day comes, we shall be judged from this, and on this basis we shall receive the eternal verdict. (Diary, 1158)

#### Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence.

**Fasting:** Catholics between the ages of 18 to 59 are obligated to eat only one full meal, and, if necessary to maintain strength, two smaller meals not equaling a full meal. No snacking in between meals.

**Abstinence:** Catholics 14 years old and above are to abstain from meat. Eating meat from any mammal (e.g., beef, pork) or bird (e.g., chicken, turkey) is not permitted. Fish and other seafood are allowed.
