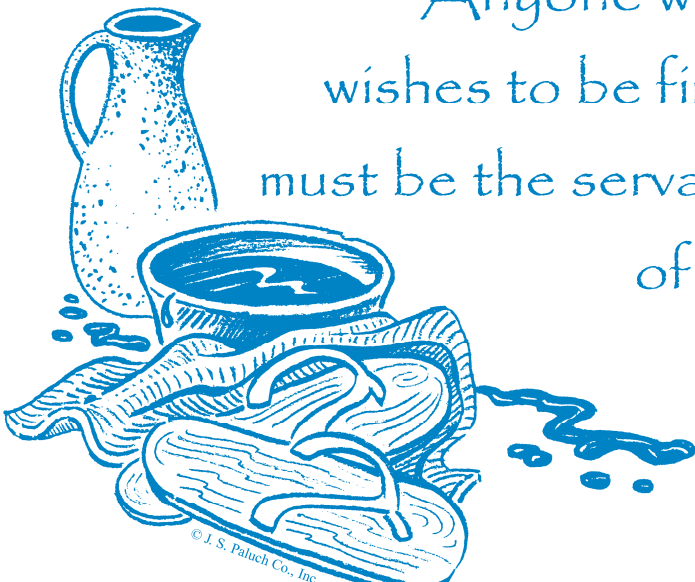

### SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

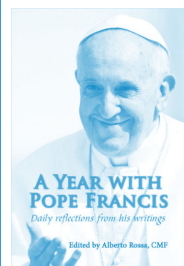
