PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Fellow members of St. Joachim Parish Community, **THANK YOU** for your support of our BIG annual parish Harvest Festival and fund raiser. Your participation by way of sharing your time, talent and treasure is much appreciated. Your participation builds community and it supports all our efforts to make the Kingdom of God more present in Madera through worship, evangelization, catechesis, and service to the needy. **THANKS**, also, for your steady contributions to the weekly offertory collections and 2nd collections for the up-building of our local, regional and international Catholic church. I have in front of me a list of more than 40 significant parish expenditures from the last two years, expenditures that benefit us all, expenditures that fall into categories of directly supporting church ministries and for maintaining church properties and buildings. In this Pastor's Corner I will mention just five of the expenditures. Others will be highlighted in Pastor's Corners to come.

1. \$115,000.00 for upgrading church, parking lot and parish center lighting to LED lights and fixtures. This is expected to save \$7,000.00 per year in PG&E electricity bills.
2. \$20,000.00 for re-upholstering church kneelers and sanctuary furniture and for re-painting the church foyer and side entrances.
3. \$28,000.00 to upgrade our church and Holy Spouses Hall sound systems with new speakers, amplifiers and mixers.
4. \$34,000.00 spent to repair, and sometimes replace, air conditioning units in the church, rectory, parish center classrooms, and parish halls –Holy Spouses, Griffin, & St. Agnes.
5. \$25,000.00 spent on re-sealing and striping the church, parish center and Holy Spouses Hall parking lots.

1. \$ 115,000.00 para la actualización de la iglesia, el estacionamiento y la iluminación del centro parroquial con luces LED y sus accesorios. Con ello se espera ahorrar \$ 7,000.00 por año en facturas de electricidad, PG&E.
2. \$ 20,000.00 para la re-tapizar los reclinatorios de la iglesia y los muebles del santuario y para volver a pintar el vestíbulo de la iglesia y entradas laterales.
3. \$ 28,000.00 para actualizar nuestros sistemas de audio en la Iglesia y en el Salón de los Santos Esposos con nuevos altavoces, amplificadores y mezcladores.
4. Un gasto de \$ 34,000.00 para reparar y, a veces reemplazar, unidades del aire acondicionado en la iglesia, rectoría, y en los salones del centro parroquial, Santos Esposos, Griffin, y Santa Inés.
5. Un gasto de \$ 25,000.00 para resellar y poner rayas en los estacionamientos de la Iglesia, Centro Parroquial y Salón Santos Esposos.
