PASTOR'S CORNER

Pope Francis' Invitation (Part One): "I invite all Christians, everywhere, at this very moment, to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus Christ. I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day" (Joy of the Gospel 3). You may have the question, "How ought I to renew my personal encounter with Jesus today and every day?" In this and the next two Pastor's Corners, I will outline a very simple and powerful way to renew "my personal encounter with Jesus Christ." The first step is to focus on what Jesus is praying for: "Father, I pray that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one (Jn. 17:23). Next, I should respond to this desire of Jesus' heart with an appropriate prayer of my own. But how and what? I suggest that we use the Lord's Prayer.

THE LORD'S PRAYER: Why is it so central for our worship and our spiritual life? When "one of his disciples said, "Lord, teach us to pray, ... Jesus said to them, when you pray say: "Our Father who art in heaven..." (Lk. 11:2; Mt. 6:9) Thus, in the tradition of the Church, the Lord's prayer has become the model of all prayer. It covers past, present and future. It expresses faith, hope and charity. It contains everything we really need, and it's guaranteed! Jesus explained that it is not enough to say the words of this prayer only with our lips. The Holy Spirit is given to enable us to pray it with our minds and from our hearts; addressing God as "Abba - Father" with childlike trust, and honoring Jesus as Lord with an obedient spirit. God is waiting to pour the benefits of this prayer into our lives. He awaits our free decision to ask for what He already wants to give us. (More next week.)

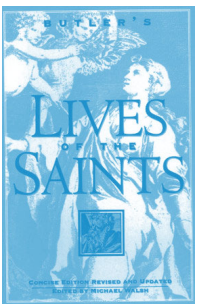

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Invitación del Papa Francisco (Parte Uno): "Invito a cada cristiano, en cualquier lugar y situación en que se encuentre, a renovar ahora mismo su encuentro personal con Jesucristo o, al menos, a tomar la decisión de dejarse encontrar por Él, de intentarlo cada día sin descanso." (La Alegría del Evangelio 3) Usted se preguntará, "¿Cómo debería yo renovar mi encuentro personal con Jesús hoy y siempre?" En este y en los dos siguientes Rincones del Párroco, describiré una manera muy sencilla y potente para renovar "mi encuentro personal con Jesucristo." El primer paso es concentrarse en saber por quien está orando Jesús: "Yo en ellos y tú en mí, para que lleguen a la unión perfecta, y el mundo pueda reconocer así que tú me has enviado, y que los amas a ellos como me amas a mí." (Jn. 17:23) Después, debería responder a este deseo del corazón de Jesús con una oración apropiada de mi parte. Pero, ¿cómo? ¿Y de qué manera? Sugiero que usemos el Padre Nuestro.

El Padre Nuestro: ¿Porqué es tan importante para nuestra adoración y nuestra vida espiritual? "Señor, enséñanos a orar,... Jesús les dijo: Cuando oren, digan Padre nuestro, que estás en el cielo,..." (Lc. 11:2, Mt. 6:9) Por lo tanto, en la tradición de la Iglesia, el Padre Nuestro se ha convertido en el modelo de toda oración. Cubre el pasado, el presente y el futuro. Expresa fe, esperanza y caridad. Contiene todo lo que realmente necesitamos, ¡y está garantizado! Jesús explicó que no es suficiente decir las palabras de esta oración sólo con nuestros labios. El Espíritu Santo se nos da para que podamos orar con nuestra mente y de corazón; dirigirse a Dios como "Abba - Padre" con la confianza de un niño, y honrando a Jesús como Señor con un espíritu obediente. Dios está esperando derramar los beneficios de esta oración en nuestras vidas. Él espera que tomemos la decisión libremente para pedirle lo que Él ya nos quiere dar. (Más la próxima semana.)
