**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**“Family – Where life begins and love never ends!”** I attended a 50<sup>th</sup> Wedding Anniversary of good friends and this saying was on the beautifully framed picture that showed the couple in the center and the family photos of each of their 7 children with spouses and 22 grandchildren and counting surrounding them. One of the children, speaking at the reception, made the point that this was a very ordinary couple with very different and strong personalities: the wife was an extrovert, loud and never at a loss for words; the husband was an introvert, quiet, and very logical and ordered in his thought. By God’s grace they were often able to use humor to soften their conflicts. One time the wife became so upset by something her husband had failed to do that she stormed up stairs and started packing her suitcase. Her husband followed her and asked what she was doing. “I’m leaving!” was the angry reply. After some stunned silence, the husband went to the closet, pulled out his suitcase and began to pack. “What are you doing?” she asked. “I’m going with you,” he replied, “I’m certainly not going to stay here alone with all these kids!” With that, the tension was broken and they began to talk about what was wrong. This ordinary couple did something that anyone can do: they adopted God’s meaning for their marriage and family. The primary purpose of each spouse in the marriage is to help the other make it to heaven. The primary shared purpose of the couple as parents is to help each of their children to make it to heaven. True love wants the best for the other and is ready to love sacrificially to achieve that end. Through all the challenges that face families today, in a culture that is more and more hostile to Christian values, this couple chose to do simple, ordinary and important things: the father gave up a high paying job and found one that enabled him to be home for a family meal every night; the father led a family rosary every night, the couple attended Mass often, even daily... In this historic time of the papal visit, the World Meeting of Families and the Synod on the Family, let us all ask, “What can I do to help and heal my own family relationships and to support the vocation to marriage and family in the Church and in the world?”

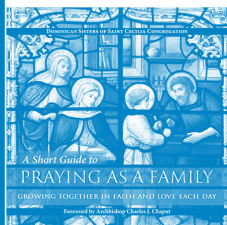

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**"Familia – Donde la vida comienza y el amor nunca termina."** Asistí a un Aniversario de Bodas de 50 años de unos buenos amigos, y esta frase estaba bellamente enmarcada en la placa que mostraba a la pareja en el centro de la foto y alrededor de esa foto, había más fotos de sus 7 hijos con sus cónyuges y sus 22 nietos. Uno de los niños, al hablar en la recepción, resaltó de que se trataba de una pareja muy normal, con personalidades muy diferentes y fuertes: la mujer era una persona extrovertida, fuerte y nunca se quedaba sin palabras; el marido era un introvertido, tranquilo, y muy lógico y ordenado en sus pensamientos. Por la gracia de Dios, fueron capaces de utilizar el humor para suavizar sus conflictos. Una vez la mujer llegó a estar tan molesta por algo que su marido no había podido hacer que ella irrumpió por las escaleras y comenzó a empacar su maleta. Su marido la siguió y le preguntó que qué estaba haciendo. "¡Me voy!", contestó enojada. Después de un silencio de asombro, el marido fué al armario, sacó su maleta y empezó a empacar. "¿Qué estás haciendo?" le preguntó la esposa. "Me voy contigo," respondió el marido: "¡Desde luego, no me voy a quedar aquí solo con todos estos niños!" Con eso, la tensión se rompió y comenzaron a hablar de lo que había pasado. Esta pareja ordinaria hizo algo que cualquiera puede hacer: adoptaron el significado de Dios para el matrimonio y la familia. El propósito principal de cada cónyuge en el matrimonio es ayudar al otro a que llegue al Cielo. El propósito principal de la pareja como padres es ayudar a que cada uno de sus hijos llegue al Cielo. El verdadero amor quiere lo mejor para el otro y está listo a sacrificarse por amor para así lograr ese finalidad. A través de todos los desafíos que enfrentan las familias de hoy, en una cultura que cada vez es más hostil a los valores cristianos, esta pareja decidió hacer las cosas simples, comunes e importantes: el padre renunció a un trabajo muy bien pagado y encontró uno que le permitía estar en casa para la cena familiar; el padre dirigía un rosario en familia cada noche, la pareja asistía a misa con frecuencia, incluso a diario... En este momento histórico de la visita papal, el Encuentro Mundial de las Familias y el Sínodo sobre la Familia, preguntémosnos todos: "¿Qué puedo hacer para ayudar y sanar las relaciones familiares entre mi familia y cómo puedo apoyar la vocación al matrimonio y a la familia en la Iglesia y en el mundo?"
