PASTOR'S CORNER

TWO URGENT WORKS OF MERCY!: 1) **Over-turn California's Assisted Suicide Law;** and, 2) **Restore Parental Rights in California to prevent the abuse of minors and the abortion of innocents.** I invite all to pray and fast, and, I invite registered voters to sign the petitions that will place two referendums on the ballot for June of 2016. On the first two Sundays of Advent, Nov. 28—29 and Dec. 5-6, more information and petitions to sign will be available to registered voters at the tables on both sides of the church after all Masses. Vulnerable children and vulnerable sick and elderly adults are very much at risk from the "travesty of compassion" that seeks to solve personal and social problems with imposed death.

In speaking to Italian doctor's last year, His Holiness, Pope Francis, spoke clearly to all of us: "The dominant thinking sometimes suggests a "false compassion," that which believes that it is: helpful to women to promote abortion; an act of dignity to obtain euthanasia; a scientific breakthrough to "produce" a child and to consider it to be a right rather than a gift to welcome; or to use human lives as guinea pigs presumably to save others. Instead, the compassion of the Gospel is that which accompanies in times of need, that is, the compassion of the Good Samaritan, who "sees," "has compassion," approaches, and provides concrete help (cf. Lk. 10:33).

Let us welcome Jesus, the divine Good Samaritan, to live in our hearts. In His Love let us stand against the evils of the culture of death. Let us reach out in compassion to those most in need and in danger of death.

Today's scriptures provide a perfect Jubilee preparation. Jeremiah comforts us with the promise of God's justice; Paul challenges us to abound in love for all; Luke bids us anticipate Jesus' future coming as the joyful advent of our redemption. But in a unique way, this Jubilee Year's Advent reminds us that Jesus, whose coming we await, is already present among us, in those for whom we need to become instruments of God's mercy.

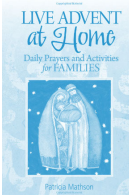
