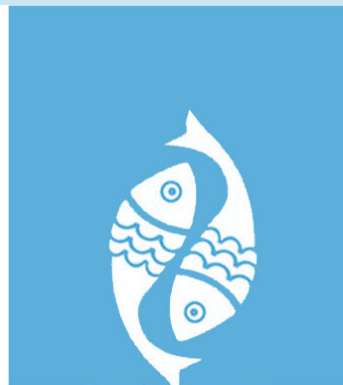

PASTOR'S CORNER

MARRIAGE IN CHRIST. When Jesus taught, "What God has joined, let no man put asunder," (Mt. 19:6) his disciples thought he was proposing an impossible standard for marriage. They said, "If that's the way it is between a man and his wife, it would be better not to marry." (Mt. 19:10) But Jesus did not give his teaching as some "pie in the sky" ideal. He lived his teaching. When we see the image of Jesus hanging on the cross, we must be mindful that he is not only on the cross as our Savior; he is also on the cross as our Bridegroom. Jesus is in a "one flesh" marriage relationship with the human race. Jesus refers to himself as "bridegroom" (Mt. 9:15), and the Book of Revelation tells us that all of human history is heading toward the "Wedding Feast of the Lamb" (Rev. 19:7). So we must see that our Bridegroom is on the cross, and that it was our sins, the unfaithfulness of the bride, from Adam and Eve to the end of time, that put Him on the cross. In this light we come to understand sin as a petition for divorce. When I sin, I am saying that I want to be separated from God's Will and distant from Jesus, the Divine Bridegroom. We must admit that if anyone ever deserved a divorce, it was Jesus. Yet Jesus taught, "What God has joined together, let no human being put asunder." He lived his teaching when, instead of accepting the billions of petitions for divorce, He prayed, "Father forgive them. They do not know what they are doing." (Lk.23:34) Through this prayer and through his resurrection from the dead, Jesus showed that all the power of hell and all the forces of human weakness and sinfulness, are incapable of putting asunder what God has joined together. How will I respond to such mercy, grace and love? It is my faithfulness to my marriage to Christ that will determine the strength of the marriage bond I have with a human spouse in Christ. Marriage in Christ: where life begins and love never ends!

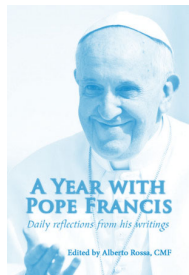

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

MATRIMONIO EN CRISTO. Cuando Jesús enseñó: "Lo que Dios unió, que no lo separe el hombre." (Mt. 19:6) sus discípulos pensaban que estaba proponiendo un nivel imposible para el matrimonio. Ellos dijeron: "Si tal es la situación del hombre con respecto a su mujer, es mejor no casarse." (Mt. 19:10) Pero Jesús no dio su enseñanza como algún ideal de "pura fantasía". Él vivió su enseñanza. Cuando vemos la imagen de Jesús colgada en la cruz, debemos ser conscientes de que no sólo está en la cruz como nuestro Salvador; también está en la cruz como nuestro Novio. Jesús está en una relación matrimonial de "una sola carne" con la raza humana. Jesús se refiere a sí mismo como "el novio" (Mt. 9:15), y en el libro de Apocalipsis nos dice que toda la historia humana se dirige hacia las "Bodas del Cordero" (Ap. 19:7). Así que debemos ver que nuestro Novio está en la cruz, y que fueron nuestros pecados, la infidelidad de la novia, desde Adán y Eva hasta el final de los tiempos, lo que lo puso en la cruz. En este sentido llegamos a entender que el pecado es como una petición de divorcio. Cuando pecco, estoy diciendo que quiero estar separado de la Voluntad de Dios y lejos de Jesús, el Novio Divino. Debemos admitir que si alguien merecía un divorcio, era Jesús. Sin embargo, Jesús nos enseñó: "Lo que Dios unió, que no lo separe el hombre." Vivió su enseñanza cuando, en lugar de aceptar los miles de millones de peticiones de divorcio, Él oró: "Padre, perdónalos, porque no saben lo que hacen." (Lc. 23:34). A través de esta oración y por su resurrección de entre los muertos, Jesús mostró que todo el poder del infierno y todas las fuerzas de la debilidad humana y del pecado, son incapaces de separar de lo que Dios ha unido. ¿Cómo responderé a tal misericordia, gracia y amor? Es mi fidelidad a mi matrimonio con Cristo lo que determinará la fuerza del vínculo matrimonial que tengo con un cónyuge humano en Cristo. ¡Matrimonio en Cristo: donde comienza la vida y el amor nunca termina!
