PASTOR'S CORNER

“Forgiveness of sins is what the gospel is all about. Forgiveness of sins is what Christ’s death upon the cross is all about. The purpose of Lent is to arouse. To arouse the sense of sin. To arouse a sense of guilt for sin. To arouse the humble contrition for the guilt of sin that makes forgiveness possible. To arouse the sense of gratitude for the forgiveness of sins. To arouse or to motivate the works of love and the works for justice that one does out of gratitude for the forgiveness of one’s sins.

To say it again – this time backward: There is no motivation for works of love without a sense of gratitude, no sense of gratitude without forgiveness, no forgiveness without contrition, no contrition without a sense of guilt, no guilt without a sense of sin. In other words, a guilty suffering spirit is more open to grace than an apathetic smug soul.” (by Edna Hong from the book, Bread and Wine – Readings for Lent and Easter.) Consider the ground of all sin, which is a failure to trust in God, which leads to the state of trying to be our own god.

Here’s wishing you a good examination of conscience and a good experience of Confession and Absolution in the Lenten weeks ahead. Remember: **24 Hours for the Lord – 24 Hours of Adoration and Confessions, 4 PM March 11 – 4 PM March 12 at St. Joachim Church.**

FAST & ABSTINENCE



During Lent, the Church asks us to enter into this season of renewal with a spirit of repentance symbolized by fasting and abstinence. **Fridays throughout Lent are days of Abstinence,**

which means that Catholics, **beginning on their 14th birthday**, abstain from meat on these days. That includes poultry, but not fish and other seafood .

Good Friday is designated as a day of Fast and Abstinence. The obligation to **fast commences on the 18th birthday and ceases on the 59th birthday.** This means that besides one full meal, the other two meals should not equal a full meal. There should be no snacking. The idea is to eat simply.

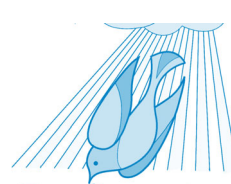

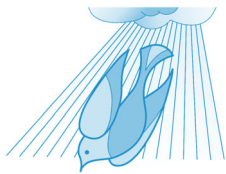

Para despertar el sentido del pecado. Para despertar un sentimiento de culpa por el pecado. Para despertar la contrición humilde de la culpa del pecado que hace posible el perdón. Para despertar el sentido de gratitud por el perdón de los pecados. Para excitar ó para motivar las obras de amor y de justicia que uno hace en agradecimiento por el perdón de nuestros pecados.

Para decirlo de nuevo - de otra manera: No hay motivación para obras de amor sin un sentido de gratitud, no tiene sentido la gratitud sin perdón, no hay perdón sin arrepentimiento, no hay contrición sin un sentimiento de culpa, no hay culpa y sin un reconocimiento del pecado. En otras palabras, un espíritu que sufre de culpabilidad es más abierto a la gracia, que una alma presumida y apática.” (De Edna Hong de su libro, Bread and Wine – Readings for Lent and Easter).
