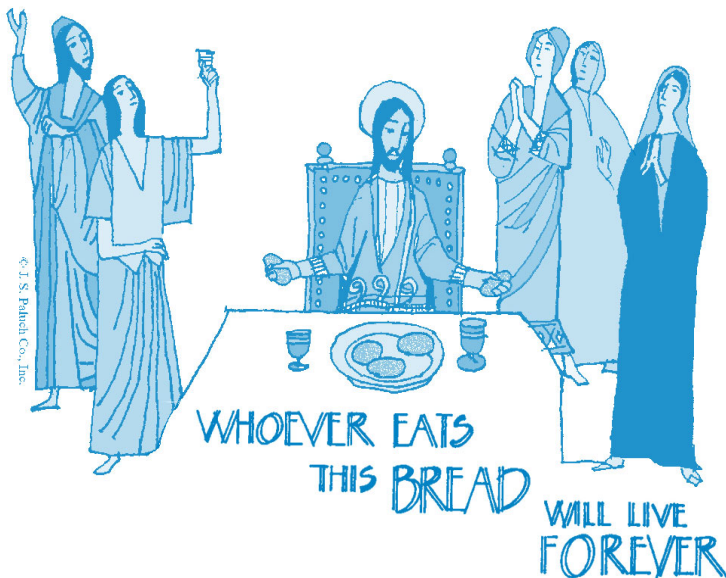

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**The Elephant in the Room.** Why did close to 90% of Irish young people, ages 18-20, vote for a re-definition of marriage as "genderless" in the recent referendum to change the constitution of their nation? These young people had been through 12 years of Catholic education. Why do some polls show that over 80% of Catholic couples in the USA generally use some form of contraception or sterilization to control the number of children they will have? The so-called "sexual revolution," which takes the sacred out of sex, substitutes lust for love, endorses fun and casual sex as a form of pre-marital and extra-marital recreation, replaces purity with porn, and advocates sterile, "safe sex," with the back-up of abortion, for the sake of reducing the number of unwanted children on the planet, is the "elephant in the room." The sexual revolution is pervasive in the dominant USA and European secular cultures of mass media and entertainment. Unfortunately, it has become pervasive even in many Catholic schools and church programs. The awesome beauty of the Catholic Church's teaching on the God-given meaning of human dignity, personhood, sexuality, marriage, family, redemption and new creation, has either not been taught well, or, it has fallen on deaf ears and dissident minds and hearts. Lord, have mercy! God help us!

This weekend our parish is sponsoring another TOB – Theology of the Body – Retreat for young people. This important bi-lingual parish Retreat Movement magnifies the light of Christ's Love and Truth, and helps to shatter the darkness of the sexual revolution. We thank the adults and young people who sacrifice to form the teams of witnesses on these retreats and we support them with our love and prayers. We also thank and support the couples who form the teams of witnesses on our parish sponsored Life-Giving Love marriage preparation retreats, classes and NFP seminars.

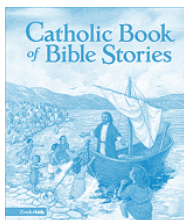

**El Elefante en la Habitación.** ¿Por qué cerca del 90% de los jóvenes irlandeses, entre 18 a 20 años de edad, vota por una nueva definición del matrimonio “sin género” en el reciente referéndum para cambiar la Constitución de su nación? Estos jóvenes habían sido durante 12 años de educación Católica. ¿Por qué algunas encuestas muestran que más del 80% de parejas Católicas en los Estados Unidos generalmente usan algún tipo de anticoncepción o esterilización para controlar el número de hijos que desean tener? La llamada “revolución sexual,” que se lleva lo sagrado del sexo, que sustituye el amor por la lujuria, endosa el sexo divertido y casual como una recreación prematrimonial y extramatrimonial, reemplaza la pureza por la pornografía y aboga por “el sexo seguro” y estéril, con el respaldo del aborto, para reducir el número de hijos no deseados en el planeta, es el elefante en la habitación.
