PASTOR'S CORNER

ASCENSION – There is cause for rejoicing here! Really? Jesus has been lifted up to be seated at the right hand of the Father and He will return in glory at the end of the age (first reading). If we think only in spatial terms, this seems cause for grieving, not joy, because Jesus, our risen and glorified Savior, is no longer visible among us. We picture Jesus way up in heaven “*above every power, authority and dominion*” (second reading). Our tendency is to picture the apostles walking back from Mt. Olivet to Jerusalem feeling bewildered, dejected, and burdened. Time for a reality check. Luke’s Gospel tells us: “*As he blessed them he parted from them and was taken up to heaven. They did him homage and then returned to Jerusalem with great joy, and they were continually in the temple praising God*” (Lk.24:51-53). What gave them great joy? The disciples were able to focus on the truth of Jesus’ last words, “*Know that I am with you always ...*” (Gospel). They were able to perceive his presence with, “*the eyes of their hearts*” (second reading). What about us? May the eyes of our hearts be enlightened that we too may be infused with the joy of the Gospel. **There is cause for rejoicing here!**

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

ASCENSION - ¡Es motivo de regocijo! ¿De verdad? Jesús ha resucitado para estar sentado a la derecha del Padre y de nuevo vendrá con gloria hasta el fin del mundo (primera lectura). Si sólo pensamos en términos espaciales, esto parece ser motivo de aflicción, no de alegría, porque Jesús nuestro Salvador resucitado y glorificado, ya no es visible entre nosotros. Imaginamos a Jesús arriba en el cielo "*por encima de todo poder, autoridad y dominio*" (segunda lectura). Nuestra tendencia es imaginarnos a los apóstoles caminando de regreso del Monte de los Olivos a Jerusalén sintiéndose desconcertados, abatidos y agobiados. Es tiempo de verificación de la realidad. El Evangelio de Lucas nos dice: *Y mientras los bendecía, se alejó de ellos y fue llevado al cielo. Ellos se postraron ante él y volvieron muy alegres a Jerusalén, donde permanecían constantemente en el Templo alabando a Dios*" (Lc.24:51-53). ¿Qué les dio gran alegría? Los discípulos fueron capaces de concentrarse en la verdad de las últimas palabras de Jesús. "*Sean que Yo estoy con ustedes siempre....*" (Evangelio). *Ellos fueron capaces de percibir su presencia con, "la iluminación de la mente"* (segunda lectura). ¿Y nosotros? Puede ser iluminada nuestra mente para que nosotros también seamos infundidos con la alegría del Evangelio. **¡Es motivo de regocijo!**
