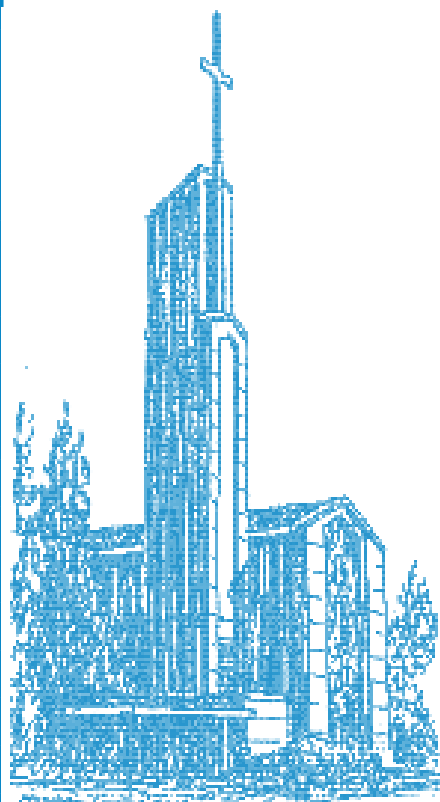

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Humility: the virtue of being in harmony with Truth and in touch with Reality.**

I was enjoying a dinner with my friends Juan and Fr. Miguel when the waitress approached and asked, "More iced tea?" Juan replied, "No. I'm good." Fr. Miguel reminded Juan of the Gospel where Jesus stated, "*No one is good but God alone*" (Mk. 10:18). This led to a discussion on the meaning of humility. I recalled a question once asked of a famous preacher: "Does being humble mean thinking little of your self?" The preacher replied, "No. Being humble means not thinking of your self at all." This thought provoking answer can make us think of Jesus who is our ultimate and absolute model of what it means to be humble. "*Who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, ... he humbled himself, becoming obedient to death, even death on a cross*" (Phil. 2:6-8). In other words, Jesus was so humble, that is, in touch with the reality of his Father's love, that he was freed from a focus on his own needs and freed for a focus on serving the needs of others, even to the point of total self sacrifice. Pope Francis put it this way in a recent homily (1/7/14): "*If a thought, if a desire takes you along the road of humility and abasement, of service to others, it is from Jesus, but if it brings you to the road of sufficiency, of vanity, of pride, along the path of abstract thought, it is not from Jesus.*"

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**Humildad: virtud de estar en armonía con la Verdad y en contacto con la Realidad.**

Me recordó de una pregunta que una vez le hicieron a un famoso predicador: ¿Ser humilde significa pensar poco de sí mismo?" El predicador respondió, "No. Ser humilde significa no pensar en ti del todo." Esta reflexión nos hace pensar en Jesús quien es nuestro último y absoluto modelo de lo que significa ser humilde. *"Quien, aunque estuviera en forma de Dios, no consideró la igualdad con Dios algo de lo que se pudo aprovechar. Por el contrario, .... se humilló, siendo obediente hasta la muerte, incluso la muerte en la cruz"* (Fil. 2:6-8). En otras palabras, Jesús era tan humilde, es decir, estaba tan en contacto con la realidad del amor de su Padre, que fué liberado del enfoque centrado en sus propias necesidades y liberado para servir a las necesidades de los demás, incluso al punto del sacrificio total. El Papa Francisco lo puso de esta manera en una reciente homilía (1/7/14): *"Si un pensamiento, o si un deseo te lleva por el camino de la humildad y la humillación para el servicio de los demás, viene de Jesús, pero si te lleva por el camino de presunción, de vanidad, de orgullo, junto con un pensamiento abstracto, no viene de Jesús."*
