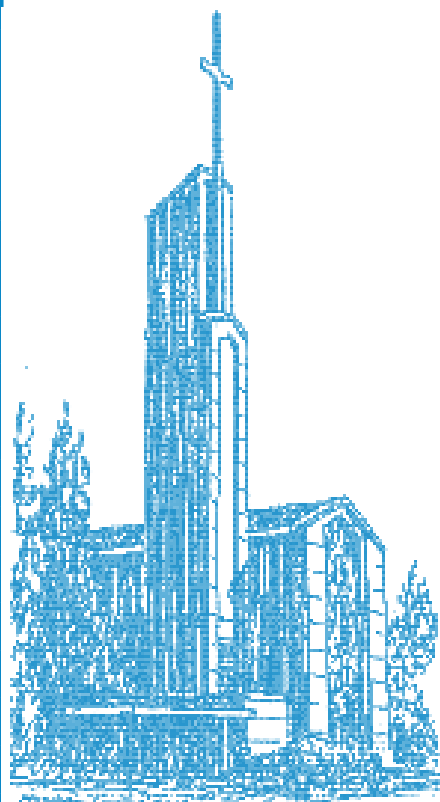

PASTOR'S CORNER

IT'S WAR! (PART 2)

"We are now standing in the face of the greatest historical confrontation humanity has gone through... the final confrontation between the Gospel and the anti-Gospel... with all its consequences for human dignity, individual rights, human rights and the rights of nations" (Karol Cardinal Wojtyla, Philadelphia, 1976). "May prayer strengthen us for the spiritual battle we are told about in the Letter to the Ephesians, 'Draw your strength from the Lord and his mighty power' (Eph. 6:10). The Book of Revelation refers to this same battle recalling before our eyes the image of St. Michael the Archangel (Rev. 12:7). Pope Leo XIII certainly had a very vivid recollection of this scene, when at the end of the last century, (1886), he introduced a special prayer to St. Michael throughout the Church. 'St. Michael the Archangel defend us in battle, be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil.'... I ask everyone to not forget it and to recite it to obtain help in the battle against the forces of darkness and against the spirit of this world" (Regina Caeli Message, Blessed John Paul II, 4/24/1994).

Beginning with Ash Wednesday, I invite your response to this serious exhortation of Blessed John Paul II. While avoiding adding a devotional prayer to the Sacred Liturgy, I consider it most convenient and beneficial to provide an opportunity to pray the prayer to St. Michael as a community after the final blessing and dismissal of the Mass or after the recessional song. The prayer to St. Michael and the traditional Oblate ending to all prayer services will normally be led by the cantor. It will be printed on the back of the pew card with the Latin Mass responses that we use during the Masses of Lent. Thank you for taking this spiritual warfare seriously.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

ES LA GUERRA! (Parte 2)

"Nos encontramos actualmente en la mayor confrontación histórica por la que la humanidad ha pasado.... La confrontación final entre el Evangelio y el anti-Evangelio... con todas sus consecuencias de la dignidad humana, los derechos individuales, humanos y los de las naciones unidas" (Karol Cardinal Wojtyla, Filadelfia, 1976). *"Que la oración nos fortalezca para la batalla espiritual que se nos narra en la Carta a los Efesios "Confortaos en el Señor y en la potencia de su fortaleza"(Ef. 6:10). El Libro del Apocalipsis se refiere a esta misma batalla recordando ante nuestros ojos la imagen de San Miguel Arcángel (Apo. 12:7). El Papa Leo XIII tenía un recuerdo muy vivo de esta escena, cuando a finales del siglo pasado (1886), presentó una oración especial de San Miguel a la Iglesia. 'San Miguel el Arcángel defiéndenos en esta batalla, sé nuestra protección contra la maldad y las trampas del diablo'...les pido a todos que no la olviden y la reciten para obtener ayuda en la batalla contra las fuerzas del mal y contra el espíritu de este mundo"* (Regina Caeli Mensaje, del Beato Juan Pablo II 4/24/1994).

Comenzando el Miércoles de Ceniza, les invito a que respondan a esta grave exhortación del Beato Juan Pablo II. Al mismo tiempo que evitar añadir una oración devocional de la Sagrada Liturgia, considero conveniente y beneficioso brindar la oportunidad de rezar la oración a San Miguel en comunidad después de la bendición final o después del canto recesional. La oración a San Miguel y el final tradicional de los Oblatos de todos los servicios de oración normalmente serán dirigidos por el cantor. Estará impreso en la tarjeta junto con las respuestas que usamos en la Misa en Latin durante las Misas de Cuaresma localizada en la parte posterior del banco. Gracias por tomar esta guerra espiritual en serio.
