PASTOR'S CORNER

The legalization of abortion in our nation was a worse mistake than the legalization of the slave trade. It took the courage of Abraham Lincoln and a civil war to correct the slavery mistake. What will it take to correct the abortion mistake? We must pray, work and yes, **vote**, to end abortion. "How can you simplify the abortion issue for those who think it's hopelessly complex? Think of the acronym **SLED** as a helpful reminder: **S**ize: Size doesn't equal value. Do we really want to say that large people are more human than small ones? **L**evel of development: Should older children have more rights than their younger siblings? **E**nvironment: Where you are has no bearing on who you are. **D**egree of dependency: If viability makes us human, then all those who depend on insulin or kidney medication are not valuable and we may kill them" (Scott Klusendorf: www.prolifetraining.com). Although human beings differ with respect to talent, age, health and the extrinsic dignity based on accomplishment, all human beings are equal with respect to the intrinsic dignity of being created in God's image and likeness and are "endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights of life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness" (Thomas Jefferson). It is precisely this intrinsic human dignity and the unalienable right to life which is violated in every elective abortion. God bless all who participated in the campaign of 40 days of prayer for life. The Fall campaign is ended but the battle for life, liberty and justice for all continues.
