**THE FEAST OF MERCY
Floodgates of Mercy**

I desire that there be a feast of Mercy. I want this image, which you will paint with a brush, to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter; that Sunday is to be the Feast of Mercy. ... I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy. ... On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. (Diary, 49, 699)

On the last and greatest day of the feast, Jesus stood up and exclaimed, "Let anyone who thirsts come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as scripture says: 'Rivers of living water will flow from within him.' " ... On that day, the mountains shall drip new Wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, All the streams of Judah will flow with water. A spring will rise from the house of the Lord, watering the Valley. (John 7:37-38; Joel 4:18).
