PASTOR'S CORNER

Theology of the Body – what is it?

“When speaking to the youth of Uganda, Saint John Paul II offered a succinct explanation of God’s plan for human love and sexuality: *‘Essential to your preparation for marriage is your vocation to chastity.* I know that young people reject hypocrisy. You want to be honest with yourselves and others. A chaste person is honest. ...*Besides expressing ourselves through speech, we express ourselves through our bodies.* ... Sexual actions are “words” that reveal our hearts. *The Lord wants us to use our sexuality according to his plan.* Honest sexual “language” requires a commitment to lifelong fidelity. To give your body to another person symbolizes the total gift of yourself to that person. But if you are not married, you are admitting that you might change your mind in the future. Total self-giving would then be absent. *Without the bond of marriage, sexual relations are a lie.* ...Do not be deceived by the empty words of those who ridicule chastity or your capacity for self control.” (From Saint John Paul the Great – His Five Loves, p. 98, by Jason Evert.

¿Qué es—Teología del cuerpo?

“Hablando a la juventud de Uganda, San Juan Pablo II ofreció una breve explicación del plan de Dios para el amor humano y la sexualidad: *“Su vocación a la castidad es esencial para su preparación para el matrimonio.* Sé que los jóvenes rechazan la hipocresía. Quieren ser honestos con ustedes mismos y con los demás. Una persona casta es honesta. *...Además de expresarnos a nosotros mismos a través del lenguaje, nos expresamos a través de nuestros cuerpos.* ...Acciones sexuales son “palabras” que nuestros corazones revelan. *El Señor quiere que utilicemos nuestra sexualidad según su plan.* El “lenguaje” sexual honesto requiere de un compromiso de fidelidad que dure toda la vida. Entregar tu cuerpo a otra persona simboliza el regalo total de sí mismo a esa persona. Pero si no estas casado, estas admitiendo que podrías cambiar de opinión en el futuro. Entonces la entrega total no existiría. *Sin el vínculo del matrimonio, las relaciones sexuales son una mentira.* ...No se deje engañar por las palabras vacías de aquellos que se burlan de la castidad o tu capacidad de autocontrol.” (De San Juan Pablo el Grande— Sus Cinco Amores, p. 98 por Jason Evert)
