PASTOR'S CORNER

May is Mary's month. We may have nostalgic memories of May crownings and Marian hymns from our childhood. But let us go beyond sentimental feelings from the past and make this month really count for deepening our own conversion, and that of all our fellow human beings. Once again, I recommend the book, *33 Days to Morning Glory*, by Fr. Michael Gaitley, MIC. Find it in the Marello book store. This book will bring alive "the example and words of Saint John Paul II. 'The most Marian Pope,' as he's been called, profoundly deepened the Church's understanding of Marian consecration ... which he also calls, 'entrustment,' and hones in on the idea that it's Mary's role to lead us into the mystery of Christ's redeeming love and self-consecration to the Father" (p. 87). Fr. Gaitley's book will also bring alive the wisdom of St. Louis de Montfort, St. Maximilian Kolbe and Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta.
