PASTOR'S CORNER

THE MEANING OF THE MASS – Confessing our sins and praying for Mercy. After the apostolic greeting comes the “Penitential Act.”

*“A humble, contrite heart, O God, you will not spurn” (Ps. 51:19). “If we say, ‘We are without sin,’ we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we acknowledge our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and cleanse us from every wrongdoing” (1 Jn. 1:9). “Brothers and sisters, let us acknowledge our sins and so prepare ourselves to celebrate the sacred mysteries” (Roman Missal). We must admit our past, present and future **need** for salvation in order to open our hearts to receive the gift of mercy offered to us in the sacred mysteries. The sacred mysteries “re-present” the “once and for all” saving sacrifice of Jesus on the cross for the forgiveness of sins. The more honestly we examine our conscience and humbly admit our need for mercy, the more disposed we will be to receive God’s mercy. We are asking God to remove every obstacle to his grace at work in us. Beyond mercy, we can receive the gift of Jesus, Himself, on ever deeper levels, and thus, enter into a deeper communion with the Trinity and one another. This is our deepest need, for our hearts are restless until they rest in God. The Mass itself has power to take away our venial sins on the condition that we are repentant. If our conscience is burdened by grave or, even mortal sin(s), we need absolution in the Sacrament of Confession or a perfect act of contrition with the intention of receiving Sacramental absolution as soon as possible, before receiving Jesus in Holy Communion (see CCC # 1452).*

EL SIGNIFICADO DE LA MISA—Confesando nuestros pecados y orando por Misericordia. Después del saludo apostólico viene el "Acto Penitencial."

"Un corazón humilde, contrito, O Dios, no despreciará" (Ps. 51:19). Si decimos, 'Estamos sin pecado,' nos engañamos y la verdad no esta en nosotros. Si reconocemos nuestros pecados, él es fiel y justo y perdonará nuestros pecados y nos limpiará de cada delito" (1 Jn. 1:9). "Hermanos y hermanas, reconozcamos nuestros pecados y preparémonos para celebrar los sagrados misterios" (Misal Romano). Hemos de admitir que el pasado, presente y futuro es necesario para nuestra salvación a fin de abrir nuestros corazones para recibir el don de la misericordia que nos ofreció en los sagrados misterios. Los sagrados misterios "re-presentan" de "una vez por todo" el sacrificio salvífico de Jesus en la cruz para el perdón de los pecados. Entre más honestamente examinemos nuestra conciencia y humildemente admitir nuestra necesidad de misericordia, estaremos más dispuestos para recibir la misericordia de Dios. Le estamos pidiendo a Dios eliminar todos los obstáculos a su gracia obrando en nosotros. Más allá de la misericordia, podemos recibir el regalo de Jesus, Mismo, en niveles más profundos, y así, entrar en una profunda comunión con la Trinidad y el uno al otro. Esta es nuestra necesidad más profunda, ya que nuestros corazones están inquietos hasta que descansan con Dios. La Misa misma tiene el poder de quitar nuestros pecados veniales con la condición de que estemos arrepentidos. Si nuestra conciencia esta agobiada por pecados graves o mortales, necesitamos absolución en el Sacramento de Confesión o con un acto perfecto de contrición con la intención de recibir absolución sacramental, tan pronto como sea posible, antes de recibir a Jesus en la Sagrada Comunión (ver CCC# 1452).
