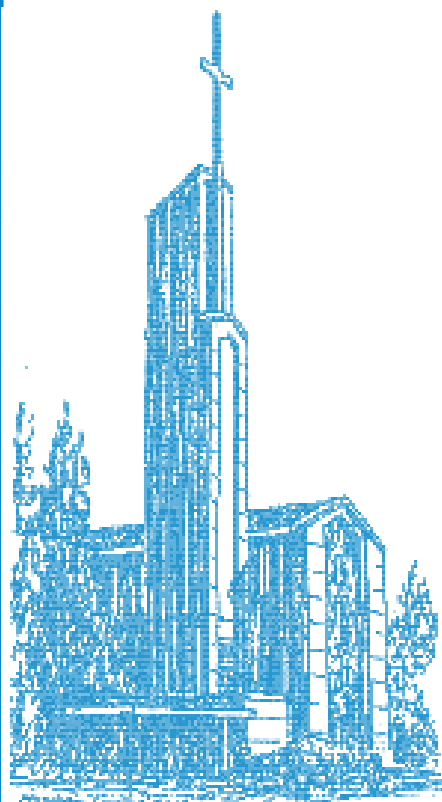

Mary is our Advent Companion.

"Am I not your Mother?," Mary asks St. Juan Diego at Tepeyac in 1531. "I am the Immaculate Conception," Mary reveals to St. Bernadette at Lourdes in 1858. Mary is "the New Eve," the "Mother of all the living," who by God's Will helps lead each human being to Jesus Christ, who is the "New Adam," who bears the only Name in Heaven or on Earth by which we are to be saved. For Mary, the veil has been lifted. She knows exactly how to pray and what to ask for each of her children. We do well to ask her to pray with us and for us "now and at the hour of our death." We do well to enter deeply into the Joyful Mysteries by praying the rosary daily during Advent. Need more motivation? ADVENT-CHRISTMAS BIBLE STUDY

•Fr. John Warburton's first Advent -Christmas Bible Study will be today from 2:30 to 4:00 pm in room 41. Today's topic: When was Jesus NOT born?

In this session we will read and study the Infancy Narratives in the Gospels of Luke and Matthew. We will probe the controversy over the date of King Herod's death. We will ask how the date of December 25, 1 BC was established by the Church as the date for Jesus' birth and the Liturgical Feast of Christmas? Why was January 6 chosen as the Liturgical feast of the Epiphany? What is the apparent contradiction in the infancy narratives of the Gospels of Luke & Matthew.
