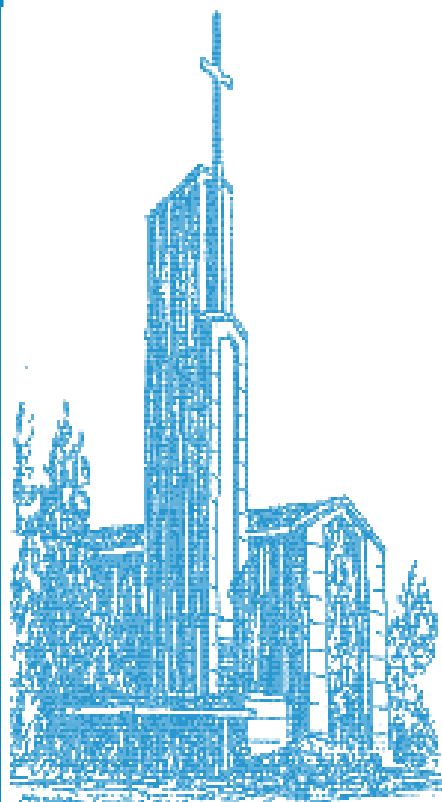

PASTOR'S CORNER

Marriage is part of God's plan to save the world. The miracle of two, or three, or a million, become one in Christ, is meant to convince the world that Jesus is sent by the Father (cf. Jn. 17:21). In the Sacrament of Matrimony, the light of that miracle is placed on a high lamp stand for all of society. As marriage goes, so goes the church. If marriage and family is strong, evangelization and missionary zeal will be strong. If marriage in Christ is weak, the Church's witness of the Gospel appears weak.

Archbishop Cordeleone of San Francisco, in his homily at the Mass before the West Coast Walk for Life, gave us these stirring words: "*Marriage is under attack... and (the attack) has been going on for at least as long as the abortion rights movement has been in existence. And it stands to reason, as both are manifestations of what Pope Francis refers to as the "throw away" culture. A baby in the womb is thrown away because at least one of the two people who brought that baby into the world has thrown the other away, has rejected the other as someone worthy of commitment, self surrender and unconditional love. This is what marriage is and is for: not a privileged social status, not a government recognition of people's love life, not a special relationship one stays in as long as one is deriving some immediate benefit from it, but a self surrender of husband and wife to each other for the sake of the children they bring into the world – just like Christ and the Church, as St. Paul teaches us (cf. Eph.5:32).*"

As the Church celebrates the annual World Marriage Day, let us pray for a renewal of holiness in all who are called to the vocation of Holy Matrimony.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

El matrimonio es parte del plan de Dios para salvar al mundo. El milagro de dos, o tres o un millón, se convierten en uno en Cristo, tiene la intención de convencer al mundo de que Jesús fue enviado por el Padre (cf. Jn. 17:21). En el Sacramento del Matrimonio, la luz de ese milagro se coloca en un alto pedestal en toda la sociedad. De acuerdo a como vaya el matrimonio así va la iglesia. Si el matrimonio y la familia están fuertes, la evangelización y el fervor misionero serán fuertes. Si el matrimonio en Cristo es débil, el testimonio de la iglesia del Evangelio parece débil.

El Arzobispo Cordeleone de San Francisco, en su homilía en la Misa antes de La Caminata por La Vida de la Costa Oeste, nos dijo estas emotivas palabras: *"El matrimonio esta bajo ataque.... Y (el ataque) ha estado ocurriendo por lo menos mientras el movimiento del derecho sobre el aborto ha existido. Y tiene razón, ya que ambas manifestaciones de lo que el Papa Francisco se refiere como una cultura "tirada". Un bebé en la matriz es tirado porque al menos una de las dos personas que lo trajeron al mundo se ha separado del otro, o lo ha rechazado como alguien digno de compromiso, de entrega y de amor incondicional. Esto es lo que es el matrimonio y para lo que es: no es una posición social privilegiada, no es un reconocimiento gubernamental del amor de tu vida, no es una relación especial en donde uno se queda hasta que uno saca un provecho inmediato de esa relación, sino una entrega del uno al otro de marido a mujer por el bien de los hijos que trajeron al mundo -- al igual que Cristo y la Iglesia, como nos lo enseña San Pablo (cf. Ef. 5:32)."*

Así como la Iglesia celebra el día Mundial del Matrimonio, oremos por una renovación de santidad de todos los que son llamados a la vocación del Santo Matrimonio.
