PASTOR'S CORNER

(St The Meaning of the MASS: Liturgy of the WORD (Part I). "Ignorance of Scripture is ignorance of Christ." (St. Jerome). "Sacred Scripture is the speech of God as it is put down in writing under the breath of the Holy Spirit." ... "Holy Tradition transmits in its entirety the Word of God which has been entrusted to the apostles by Christ the Lord and the Holy Spirit" (CCC 81). "In the supremely wise arrangement of God, Sacred Tradition, Sacred Scripture and the Magisterium of the Church are so connected and associated that one cannot stand without the others. Working together, each in its own way, under the action of the one Holy Spirit, they all contribute effectively to the salvation of souls" (CCC 95). "Faith comes from what is heard and what is heard comes by the preaching of Christ" (Romans 10:17). "By the saving Word of God, faith is nourished in the hearts of believers. ... The proclamation does not stop with a teaching; it elicits the *response of faith* as consent and commitment, directed at the covenant between God and his people" (CCC 1102). These authoritative statements from the Magisterium in the Catechism of the Catholic Church are meant to impress upon us how important the readings and the homily are as the Liturgy of the Word in the first part of every Mass.

El Significado de la MISA: Liturgia de la PALABRA (Parte I). "La Ignorancia de las Escrituras es ignorancia hacia Cristo." (San Jerónimo). "*La Sagrada Escritura es la palabra de Dios, en cuanto escrita por inspiración del Espíritu Santo.*" ..."La Santa Tradición transmite en su totalidad la palabra de Dios, encomendada por Cristo y el Espíritu Santo a los apóstoles" (CCC 81). "En la sumamente sabia disposición de Dios, la Sagrada Tradición, las Sagradas Escrituras y el Magisterio de la Iglesia, están unidos y ligados, de modo que ninguno puede subsistir sin los otros. Trabajando juntos, cada uno según su carácter, y bajo la acción del único Espíritu Santo, contribuyen eficazmente a la salvación de las almas" (CCC95). "La fe surge de la proclamación, y la proclamación se verifica mediante la palabra de Cristo" (Romanos 10:17). Con la Palabra de la salvación de Dios, la fe se alimenta en el corazón de los creyentes. ...La proclamación no se reduce a una enseñanza: *exige la respuesta de fe*, como consentimiento y compromiso, con miras a la Alianza entre Dios y su pueblo" (CCC 1102).
