PASTOR'S CORNER

“Be merciful even as your Father is merciful.” (Luke 6:36) This is the theme of our Holy Jubilee Year of Mercy. The question is, how are we to extend this kind of divine mercy to others, even to enemies? In Matthew's Gospel Jesus stated: “Not everyone can accept this precept; but ONLY THOSE WHO RECEIVE THE GIFT” (Mt. 19:11). What gift? And how are we to receive it? To answer these questions, we pose two others. What GIFT does our Heavenly Father want to give us more than anything else? Think of John 3:16. “God so loved the world that he gave...” Thus, the answer is, HIS SON! What GIFT does Jesus want to give us more than anything else? Think of John 15:4...5, “Abide in me and I in you. ... for apart from me you can do nothing.” Thus the answer is, HIMSELF! Think of John 20:22, “Receive the Holy Spirit.” Thus, the way the Father and Jesus give the GIFT of SELF to disciples is through the GIFT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT. The end result of RECEIVING THE GIFT is an ever deepening indwelling and intimate communion with God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It would be tragic if THE GIFT remains an abstract nice idea and does not become the living Gospel which transforms our lives. The Easter Season is our preparation for RECEIVING THE GIFT more deeply day by day, as in a NEW PENTECOST. Stay tuned for practical ways to RECEIVE THE GIFT.
