PASTOR'S CORNER

IT'S WAR! - Why Infant Baptism? Why Baptism shortly after birth?

“Baptism, by imparting the life of Christ’s grace, erases original sin and turns a man back toward God, but the consequences for nature, weakened and inclined to evil, persist in man and summon him to spiritual battle” (CCC 405). Adam and Eve have “transmitted to us a sin with which we are all born afflicted, a sin which is the ‘death of the soul.’ Because of this certainty of faith, the Church baptizes for the remission of sins even tiny infants who have not committed personal sins” (CCC 403). “Baptism not only purifies from all sins, but also makes the neophyte ‘a new creature,’ an adopted son of God, who has become a ‘partaker of the divine nature,’ member of Christ and co-heir with him, and a temple of the Holy Spirit” CCC 1265). “The Church and the parents would deny a child the priceless grace of becoming a child of God were they not to confer Baptism shortly after birth” (CCC 1250). “By its very nature infant Baptism requires a *post-baptismal catechumenate*” (CCC 1231). Thus, Baptism shortly after birth, and a thorough education of the child in the practice of the faith, is part of our best strategy for strengthening the child, the family and the Church in our “dour combat with the powers of evil” (CCC 409).

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

ES GUERRA! - ¿Por qué el bautismo infantil? ¿Porqué el Bautismo poco antes del nacimiento?

“El Bautismo, dando la vida de la gracia de Cristo, borra el pecado original y devuelve el hombre a Dios, pero las consecuencias para la naturaleza, debilitada e inclinada al mal, persisten en el hombre y lo llaman al combate espiritual” (CCC 405). Adán y Eva nos han “trasmitido un pecado con el que todos nacemos afectados y que es “muerte del alma.” Por esta certeza de fe, la Iglesia concede el Bautismo para la remisión de los pecados incluso a los niños que no han cometido pecado personal” (CCC 403). “El Bautismo no solamente purifica de todos los pecados, hace también del neófito “una nueva creación,” un hijo adoptivo de Dios que ha sido hecho ‘participe de la naturaleza divina,’ miembro de Cristo y coheredero con El, y templo del Espíritu Santo” (CCC 1265). “La Iglesia y los padres privarían al niño de la gracia inestimable de ser hijo de Dios si no le administrarían el Bautismo poco después de su nacimiento” (CCC 1250). “Por su naturaleza misma. El Bautismo de niños exige un *catecumenado postbautismal*” (CCC 1231). Por lo tanto, el Bautismo poco después del nacimiento, y una educación completa del niño en la práctica de la fe, es parte de nuestra mejor estrategia para fortalecer al niño, la familia y la Iglesia en nuestra “dura batalla contra los poderes de las tinieblas” (CCC 409).
