PASTOR'S CORNER

Love Is Our Mission: The Family fully Alive Part 4: Two Become One. “Jesus creates a new possibility for us, a vision of marriage based on his covenant with the Church, a marriage based on abiding permanence, chastity and mercy. (...) And we build a house together, not alone!... You would not wish to build it on the shifting sands of emotions, but on the rock of true love that comes from God... We must not allow ourselves to be conquered by a ‘throwaway culture.’ This fear of ‘forever’ is cured by entrusting oneself day by day to the Lord Jesus in a life that becomes a daily spiritual path of common growth, step by step. (...) Christ dwells with a couple, helping spouses to pick up their cross, to rise again after they have fallen, to forgive and bear one another’s burdens. Pope Francis makes a related point succinctly when he says living together is an ‘art... which can be summarized in a few simple words: please, thank you, and sorry.’ Learning to say these things can be hard. But marriages can turn very painful, very fast, when these simple words are missing. (...) Saint John Paul II’s ‘Theology of the Body’ speaks of a certain ‘interior freedom’ and ‘self-mastery’ which spouses need in order to truly make a gift of themselves to one another. (...) To live the sacramentality of marriage and to follow the way of the covenant, husbands and wives need the capacity to transcend resentment, to lay aside entitlements, and to step forward in generosity. Erotic partners focused mainly on possessing each other lack the interior skill of stepping back and making space for self-criticism, reconciliation and growth. (...) The sacramental commitment to do the work of love, even when loving is tough, is an essential ingredient in God’s covenant.” More to come.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

El Amor Es Nuestra Misión – La Familia Plenamente Viva. Parte 4: Dos Que Pasan a Ser Uno. “Jesús crea una nueva posibilidad para nosotros, una visión del matrimonio basada en su alianza con la Iglesia, un matrimonio basado en la permanencia, la castidad y la misericordia. (...) Y la casa se construye juntos, ¡no solos!... No queréis fundarla en la arena de los sentimientos que van y vienen, sino en la roca del amor auténtico, el amor que viene de Dios... Por favor no debemos dejarnos vencer por la ‘cultura de lo provisional.’ Este miedo del ‘para siempre’ se cura día a día, encomendándose al Señor Jesús en una vida que se convierte en un camino espiritual cotidiano, construido por pasos, pasos pequeños, pasos de crecimiento común. (...) Cristo permanece en la pareja, ayuda a los esposos a cargar su cruz, a levantarse después de sus caídas, a perdonarse y llevar las cargas unos a otros. El Papa Francisco se refiere brevemente a esto cuando dice que vivir juntos es un ‘arte...que se puede resumir en estas tres palabras: permiso, o sea puedo, gracias y perdón.’ Aprender a decir estas cosas puede ser difícil. Pero, cuando faltan estas palabras, los matrimonios pueden hacerse muy dolorosos rápidamente. (...) La “Teología del Cuerpo”, de San Pablo II, habla de cierta ‘libertad interior’ y ‘autodominio’ que necesitan tener los esposos para verdaderamente darse e don de sí mismos al otro. (...) Para vivir la sacramentalidad del matrimonio y seguir el camino de la alianza, los esposos necesitan la capacidad de superar el resentimiento, dejar a un lado los derechos y avanzar en la generosidad. Las parejas eróticas centradas sobre todo en la posesión mutua no tienen la habilidad interior para dar un paso atrás y hacer lugar a la autocrítica, la reconciliación y el crecimiento. (...) El compromiso sacramental de realizar la obra del amor, aun cuando amar sea difícil, es un ingrediente esencial de la alianza de Dios.” Más por venir.
