**PASTOR’S CORNER**

**The 2014 WORLD MISSION SUNDAY APPEAL is next week. BE PREPARED!**

In the early 19<sup>th</sup> century in France, a young laywoman, Pauline Jaricot, became inspired by news of the missions of her day – our own country included! She began gathering together small groups – mostly workers in her family’s silk factory. She asked each member of the group to offer daily prayer and a weekly sacrifice of a sou (the equivalent of a penny at that time), insisting that her efforts be for all the Church’s missions. From Pauline’s vision came the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. The first collection in 1822 supported the vast diocese of Louisiana, and the missions of Kentucky and China. The second collection next weekend will help support the Church’s youngest mission diocese in Mongolia along with 1,150 other mission dioceses. In a world where so much divides us, World Mission Sunday rejoices in our unity as missionary disciples of Jesus Christ. Our brothers and sisters in the Missions themselves offer their prayers and sacrifices so that others may come to know Jesus!

A principios del siglo 19 en Francia, una joven laica llamada Pauline Jaricot se vio inspirada por las noticias de las misiones de su época - incluyendo nuestro propio país! Comenzó a reunir pequeños grupos - que en su mayoría eran obreros de la fábrica de seda perteneciente a su familia. Ella le pidió a cada integrante del grupo que ofreciera una oración diaria y un sacrificio semanal de un sou (el equivalente a un centavo en esa época), insistiendo en que sus esfuerzos serían para todas las misiones de la Iglesia. De la visión de Pauline surgió la Sociedad para la Propagación de la Fe. La primera colecta de 1822 financió la vasta diócesis de Luisiana, y las misiones de Kentucky y China. La segunda colecta del próximo fin de semana ayudará a apoyar a la misión de la iglesia más joven de la diócesis de Mongolia junto con otras 1,150 diócesis. En el mundo en el que tanto nos divide, ¡el Domingo Mundial de las Misiones se goza en nuestra unidad como misioneros discípulos de Jesucristo! ¡Nuestros hermanos y hermanas en las propias Misiones ofrecen sus oraciones y sacrificios para que otros puedan conocer a Jesús!
