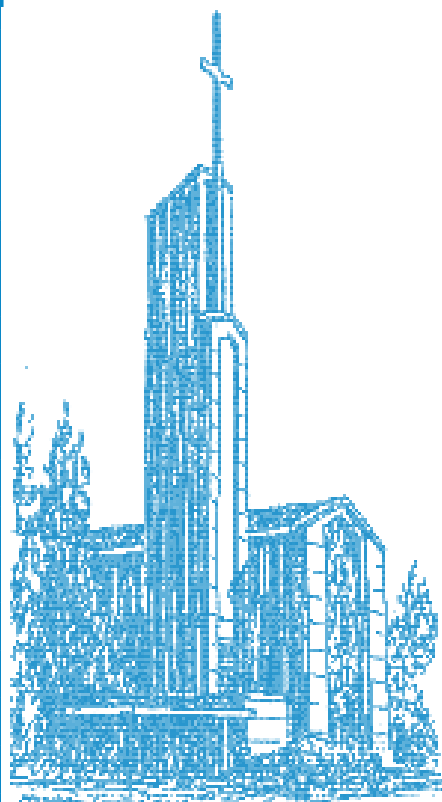

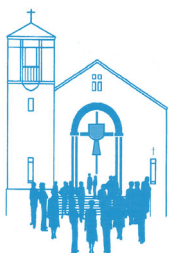

El Viernes Santo es día de ayuno y abstinencia.

Ayuno: Católicos entre los edades de 18 a 59 años están obligados hacer una sola comida fuerte y, si es necesario para mantener fuerza, dos comidas más pequeñas que no equivalen a una comida completa. No picar entre comidas.

Abstinencia: Católicos de 14 años de edad y mayor están obligados de no comer carne. Comer carne de cualquier mamífero (res, puerco) o ave (pollo, pavo) no es permitido. Comer pescado o mariscos es permitido.

Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence.

Fasting: Catholics between the ages of 18 to 59 are obligated to eat only one full meal, and, if necessary to maintain strength, two smaller meals not equaling a full meal. No snacking in between meals.

Abstinence: Catholics 14 years old and above are to abstain from meat. Eating meat from any mammal (e.g., beef, pork) or bird (e.g., chicken, turkey) is not permitted. Fish and other seafood are allowed.

HOLY FAMILY TABLE CHALLENGE

Holy Family Table is again participating in the annual Feinstein Foundation Spring Challenge to Fight Hunger. The amount of food and cash donations or pledges received between March 1 and April 30 will be added up to qualify us for a cash award based on a percentage of the total. Food donations will be valued at \$1 per item or pound and can be left at Griffin Hall between 6 & 10am any day of the week. Monetary donations should be mailed or brought to the parish office--checks made out to "Holy Family Table".
