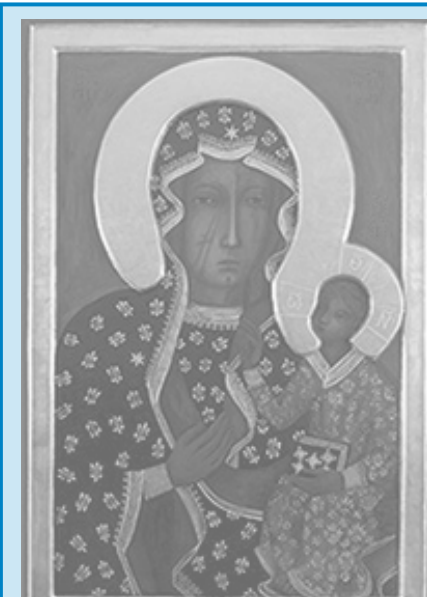

IT'S WAR! ST. MARELLO BOOKSTORE

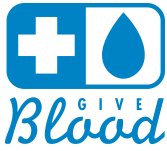

This visit is part of Human Life International's "Ocean to Ocean" Campaign for the Defense of Life and Family. A welcoming ceremony and procession are scheduled for Saturday, August 2, at 3:30 PM.

The Piarist Fathers were founded by St. Joseph Calasanz in Rome in 1617. In addition to the vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience, the Piarists take a fourth vow to educate youth.
