**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**The Meaning of the Mass – the GLORIA**

On Sundays, outside the seasons of Advent and Lent, the penitential rite is followed by a burst of praise, in a song of Glory, as first sung by angel choirs on the night of Jesus' birth, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will!" Praise opens our hearts to receive the "grace and truth" (Jn. 1:17) God wants to pour into them from the table of his Word and the altar of his Sacrifice. Our praise is "wholly directed toward the intimate union of the faithful with Christ through communion" (CCC 1382). This initial joyful hymn of praise to God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, for the gifts of creation, redemption and sanctification, will find echoes in the prayers of the Mass to come. Our praise is directed to God, but it benefits us. "Our thanksgiving is itself your gift, since our praises add nothing to your greatness but profit us for salvation through Christ our Lord" (Common Preface IV – Roman Missal). I urge us all to avoid passivity and to participate fully in the GLORIA because "We exist for the praise of his glory!" (Eph. 1:12). Praise makes us feel at home in God's Kingdom and in tune with God who is Love and who is totally praiseworthy.

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

### El Significado de la Misa - GLORIA

Los Domingos, después de la temporada de Adviento y Cuaresma, el rito penitencial es seguido por una explosión de alabanza en un canto de Gloria, como la primera cantada por los coros angelicales en el nacimiento de Jesús. “¡Gloria a Dios en las alturas, y en la tierra paz a los hombres de buena voluntad!” La alabanza abre nuestros corazones para recibir “la gracia y la verdad” (Jn. 1:17) Dios quiere verter en ellos desde la mesa de su Palabra y en el altar de su Sacrificio. Nuestra alabanza es “totalmente dirigida hacia la unión íntima de los fieles con Cristo mediante la comunión” (CCC1382). Este himno gozoso inicial de Alabanza a Dios, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, para los dones de la creación, la redención y la santificación, hará ecos en las oraciones de la Misa por venir. La alabanza se dirige a Dios, pero nos beneficia. “Nuestra acción de gracias es en sí mismo su regalo, ya que nuestras alabanzas no añaden nada a su grandeza excepto que nos benefician para la salvación mediante Cristo nuestro Señor” (Prefacio Común—Misal Romano). Insto a todos nosotros a evitar la pasividad y participar plenamente en la GLORIA porque “¡Existimos para la alabanza de su gloria!” (Eph. 1:12). La alabanza nos hace sentir como en casa en el Reino de Dios y en sintonía con Dios que es Amor y que es totalmente digno de alabanza.
